Cycling season is here, and you can't wait to hop on your bike to explore Ontario's stunning natural landscapes. The problem is... you're a city dweller. Not to worry. If you live in the GTA and find yourself craving rural routes, Metrolinx has you covered. Bring your bike on the GO Train to reach all the amazing cycling trails and pathways waiting for you beyond the urban boundaries of Toronto.

If you are a seasoned cycler, experience The Group of Seven trail, which begins at the McMichael Canadian Art Collection in Vaughan. Your nearest GO Station is Langstaff GO, a leisurely 20 km cycle away, which takes about an hour. It's the perfect distance for a first leg of your ride, which means

you've earned a rest by the time you arrive in the Village of Kleinburg. Explore charming cafes and restaurants for a quick refresher, then continue through the picturesque Humber River Valley, which inspired the work of the famous Group of Seven.

Prefer to ride along shorelines, or want a shorter pedal for your route? Your best bet is Pickering GO Station, followed by a quick spin south to reach the Great Lakes Waterfront Trail. Cycle along Lake Ontario's scenic shores all through Durham Region - as far east as you want (in fact the trail goes all the way to the Quebec border!). Hint: you can hop back on the GO Train in Oshawa for a shorter return ride if needed.
