

# East Harbour Transit Hub: Eastern Avenue Weekend Road and Sidewalk Closures

March 27<sup>th</sup> – March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026

## WHAT'S HAPPENING

East Harbour Transit Hub construction crews will be pouring a new concrete bridge deck over Eastern Avenue. A weekend road and sidewalk closure will be enacted for the deck pour between Dibble Street and McGee Street, starting at 10:00 p.m. on Friday, March 27<sup>th</sup> and ending at 5:00 a.m. on Monday, March 30<sup>th</sup>. Dates and times are subject to change.

## WHAT TO EXPECT

- East Harbour Transit Hub construction crews will be pouring a new concrete GO bridge deck over Eastern Avenue. Nightly closures on Eastern Avenue are required for this work as well as a full weekend closure.
- This work is expected to introduce levels of noise and vibration similar to those of ongoing East Harbour Transit Hub operations.
- Our operations staff are taking precautions to minimize disturbances to residents, businesses, and commuters, including but not limited to the following:
  - third-party monitoring of noise and vibration levels, at various points of reception
  - no idling of non-essential equipment
  - pointing lights away from residential windows
  - delineating safe work zones
  - off-duty police officers directing safe pedestrian and vehicular traffic

## HOURS OF WORK

- Full weekend closure beginning Friday, March 27<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 p.m. and ending Monday, March 30<sup>th</sup> at 5:00 a.m.

## LOCATION OF WORK

- During the hours of the closure, Eastern Avenue will be closed between Lewis Street and Dibble Street. During the same hours there will be local traffic only between Broadview Avenue and Lewis Street, and Between Dibble Street and Logan Avenue.

- No vehicles will be allowed between Lewis Street and Dibble Street during the times indicated in the notice. Vehicle detour routes via Dundas Street East are accessible using Broadview Avenue, Logan Avenue, and Carlaw Avenue.
- Drivers are advised to look for construction signage and obey any signage as well as instructions from traffic control persons and/or off duty officers.
