


Burlington Station: Overnight track removal

March 20th to 22nd, 2026

WHAT IS HAPPENING?

Over the weekend of the 20th to the 22nd of March, we will be removing a piece of disconnected track that is currently situated to the north of Burlington Station, as shown on the map above. This work will take place during the track closure during this weekend. Please check the GO Transit website for alternative transit options: www.gotransit.com

WHAT WORK IS TAKING PLACE?

- During the weekend of **March 20-22, 2026**, we will be removing a section of unused disconnected track to the north of Burlington Station.
- The demolition process will involve cutting the sections of rail into manageable pieces, which will then be lifted/ taken out of the construction area.
- Some noise, dust and vibration can be expected from the construction works. We will do our best to minimize this as much as possible.

HOURS OF WORK

- Work will take place during the track closure during the day and overnight for the whole weekend.

LOCATION OF WORK

- The works are located in the area of the existing station as shown on the graphic.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- There may be some minor alterations to pedestrian routes through the station which will be signposted.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- There are no other expected traffic impacts, but you can expect an increase in construction vehicles on local roads.

TRANSIT DETAILS

- The work is taking place during a closure of the station and the railway corridor. For alternative transit options please check www.gotransit.com
- Train service is running between Niagara Falls and Aldershot GO; however, trains that are regularly scheduled to begin and end at Confederation and West Harbour GO stations will not run. GO buses will replace train service at West Harbour, Aldershot, Burlington, Oakville and Clarkson GO to Union Station Bus Terminal.
- There will be no GO Transit service at Appleby, Bronte, Port Credit, Long Branch, Mimico, or Exhibition GO. Please consider TTC or local transit options to help you complete your trip.
