

GO Expansion - Utility Relocation Works near Winston Churchill Blvd & Bromsgrove Rd

February 9, 2026 - September 30, 2026

Project Overview

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Across the entire network, our goal is to deliver over 10,000 **train trips a week. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into an all-day, rapid rail system.**

What is happening?

As part of the GO Expansion Project, construction crews will be working at the Winston Churchill Boulevard rail crossing and Bromsgrove Road to support required utility relocation activities. Work will also take place at the Metrolinx bridge overpass and along Winston Churchill Boulevard between Bromsgrove Road and Royal Windsor Drive.

The scope of work includes the removal and installation of new electrical conductors along the Metrolinx corridor, the installation of new hydro poles, and horizontal directional drilling (HDD) works, including the installation of underground duct banks.

Construction will be carried out using a hybrid approach, with a combination of daytime and nighttime work periods, in accordance with Metrolinx safety standards for railway operations. These activities are necessary to support future track and rail infrastructure improvements.

Timing and what to expect

- Work is scheduled to begin on February 9, 2026 and anticipated completion by September 30, 2026.
- Construction will be carried out in phases and will not be continuous. A hybrid approach will be used, with a combination of daytime and nighttime work windows in accordance with Metrolinx's safety standards for work in the rail corridor.
- Temporary lane and sidewalk closures on the east side of Winston Churchill Boulevard between Bromsgrove Road and the rail bridge will be required.
- Temporary lane and sidewalk closures on the south side of Bromsgrove Road between Tredmore Drive and Journeyman Lane will be required in stages.
- Driveway accesses and service of the MiWay bus stop will be maintained at all times. On-site personnel will be present to safely direct traffic as needed.
- Nearby residents may experience intermittent noise from construction activities.
- Nighttime work will be minimized and limited only to critical activities that cannot be completed during daytime hours due to operational or safety requirements.
- Night time work noise will remain within the City by-laws.
- Every effort will be made to complete the work as efficiently as possible to reduce disruption; however, residents and businesses near the corridor should expect some noise associated with construction equipment.
- All dates are tentative and subject to change due to weather conditions or other unforeseen circumstances.
