Beginning Monday, March 16, Metrolinx will begin survey work at the site of the proposed Grimsby GO Station located on Casablanca Boulevard between Livingston Avenue and the South Service Road.

Later in the week, crews will be cleaning up the site, including tree branch trimming and tilling the land.

The adjacent wood lot is NOT affected by this work, which is expected to be completed by April 3, 2026.

PLEASE NOTE: Timing of this work is subject to change due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.

What to Expect

Crews will be at the site during daytime hours only between 7am and 7pm. **Neighbours may experience some noise while the site cleanup work is underway.**
