

Maple GO: Upcoming Station Works

August 2025 - October 2025, 6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

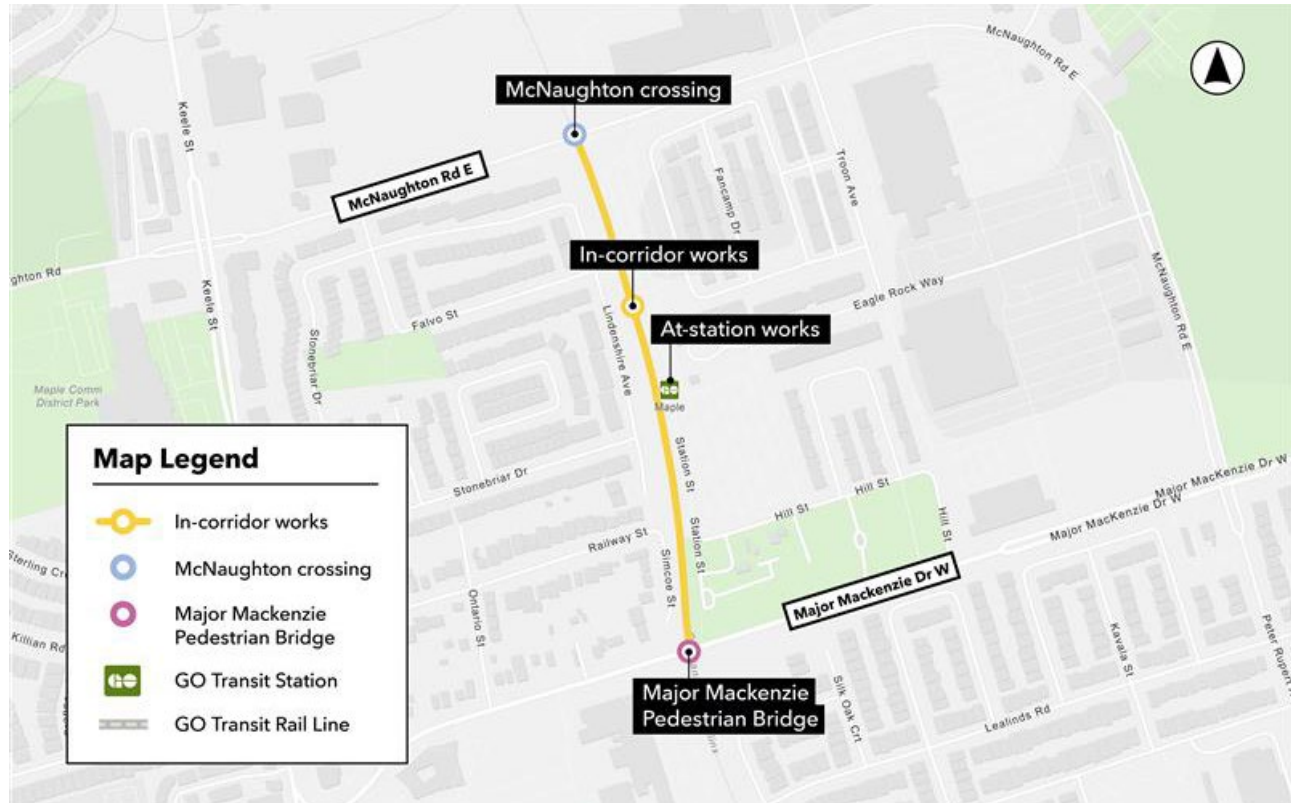


Figure 1: All work activities will occur within Maple GO station. Not to scale. Metrolinx image.

What Is Happening

To support station enhancements at Maple GO, Metrolinx will be conducting various activities at and around Maple GO Station beginning in August 2025 and ending in October 2025. These activities include:

- Station platform and parking lot improvement work.
- Paving works on various pathways and line painting at the station parking lots.
- Installation of two cantilever gates as well as drainage works near the McNaughton Crossing.
- The creation of a temporary passenger pick up/drop off area while the final one is being built, which includes asphaltting works.
- The construction of a new garbage enclosure.
- The relocation of a temporary platform and dismantling of a platform shelter.
- Installing a new bike shelter near the south parking lot.
- Construction activities at the site of the future Major Mackenzie Pedestrian Bridge.

This work will occur during daytime hours between the window of 6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. GO customers will be informed in advance of any needed rerouting or temporary customer detours at the station while these works are in progress.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Metrolinx will be conducting various works at and near Maple GO station, including within the rail corridor and at the site of the future Major Mackenzie Pedestrian Bridge.
- Nearby residents may experience some noise associated with construction activities and equipment.
- Sound and air monitoring technology will be utilized to ensure that noise levels do not exceed a 65-decibel limit in compliance with Metrolinx's construction noise criteria for residential work.
- Vibration monitors will also be used as needed, depending on the nature of work.
- Other mitigations may include:
 - Noise blankets over generators or other machinery.
 - White noise back-up beepers for trucks in the vicinity of homes.
 - Rubber tires on equipment moving along the corridor.

HOURS OF WORK

- Work will occur during daytime hours between the window of 6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

LOCATION OF WORK

- Work will occur at and around Maple GO Station.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- No pedestrian impacts are expected for works at the station.

- There may be some minor rerouting near the Major Mackenzie Pedestrian Bridge. Wayfinding signage will be in place to guide pedestrians.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- There may be minor traffic impacts associated with trucks moving in and out of the station and rail corridor to transport equipment.
- Traffic management will be in place and any lane closures to allow for equipment vehicle movement will be temporary and short-term.

TRANSIT IMPACTS

- This work will not impact GO service at Maple GO or along the Barrie line.
- YRT may experience some delays along McNaughton Road due to localized lane closures.
- Any needed at-station detours or rerouting will be communicated in advance to Maple GO customers.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

- We thank you for your patience and cooperation as we strive to bring you enhancements at Maple GO station.
