

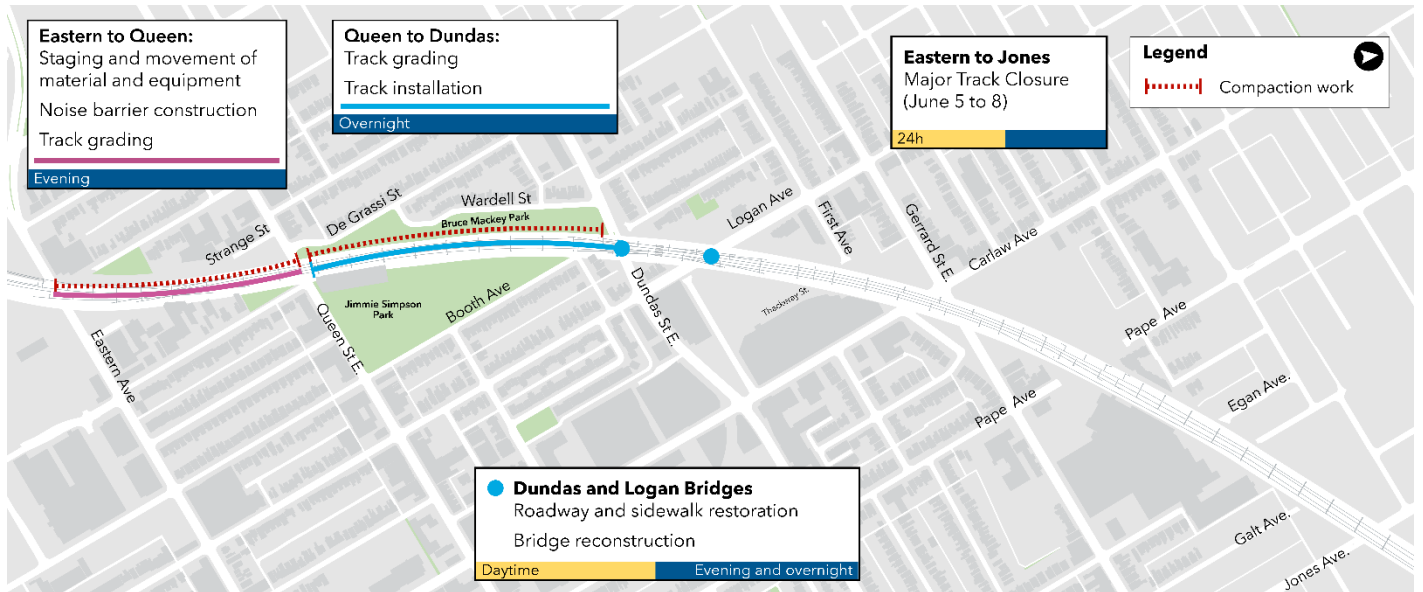
Lakeshore East Rail Corridor: Bi-weekly Construction Update

Update for the weeks of: Saturday, May 30 to Saturday, June 13, 2026

Hours of work:

- **Daytime:** Monday to Friday, with occasional weekend work, from 7 a.m. - 7 p.m.
- **Evening/overnight:** Monday to Friday from 7 p.m. - 5 a.m. (night work is dependent on each activity - see further details below).

This notice provides an update on the work happening in the rail corridor over the next two (2) weeks. As early works in the rail corridor reach completion, this bi-weekly notice will be replaced by individual construction notices for each work activity related to station construction.






What is happening?

Construction work is underway in the Lakeshore East rail corridor to prepare for the future Ontario Line. This notice provides a progress update on the works taking place in the rail corridor. The Contractor will be moving equipment and machinery throughout the corridor to access each work area and stockpile materials. The Contractor will enter the rail corridor from various access roads, including at Eastern Avenue and 449 Carlaw Ave. Certain construction activities may cause noise and vibration at nearby properties.

	Track grading Backfilling and placing material in the rail corridor. Residents closest to the rail corridor may feel some vibration during backfilling work (areas may include Strange St, Saulter St, and Queen St).	Ongoing until June 5
 Queen to Dundas	Track grading Backfilling and placing material in the rail corridor. Residents closest to the rail corridor may feel some vibration during backfilling work (areas may include Wardell St, Tiverton St, Booth Ave, Paisley Ave, and Logan Ave near Dundas St).	Ongoing until June 5
 Dundas and Logan Bridges	Bridge reconstruction Construction of final bridge elements such as approach slabs and waterproofing. Sidewalk restoration South sidewalk of Dundas St E closed for restoration and utility work until June 5. West sidewalk of Logan Ave closed for restoration work until June 12.	Ongoing until mid June 2026.

What to Expect

- Overnight work is required to complete activities that construction crews cannot do safely while trains are active and running in the corridor.
- Excavators, trucks, compactors, loaders, skid steers and mobile cranes will be used to complete work activities.
- Residents in nearby properties may experience noise and vibration from the work; monitoring is in place to ensure levels stay within acceptable limits. Various mitigation measures will be implemented to reduce disruption.
- Overnight site lighting will be positioned downward into the rail corridor and away from residential properties.
- Construction equipment and materials will be secured within the work zones.
- Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather and/or unforeseen circumstances. Work locations are subject to change and may vary based on site conditions and/or schedule requirements.
