

Woodbine GO Station: Weekend track closure work

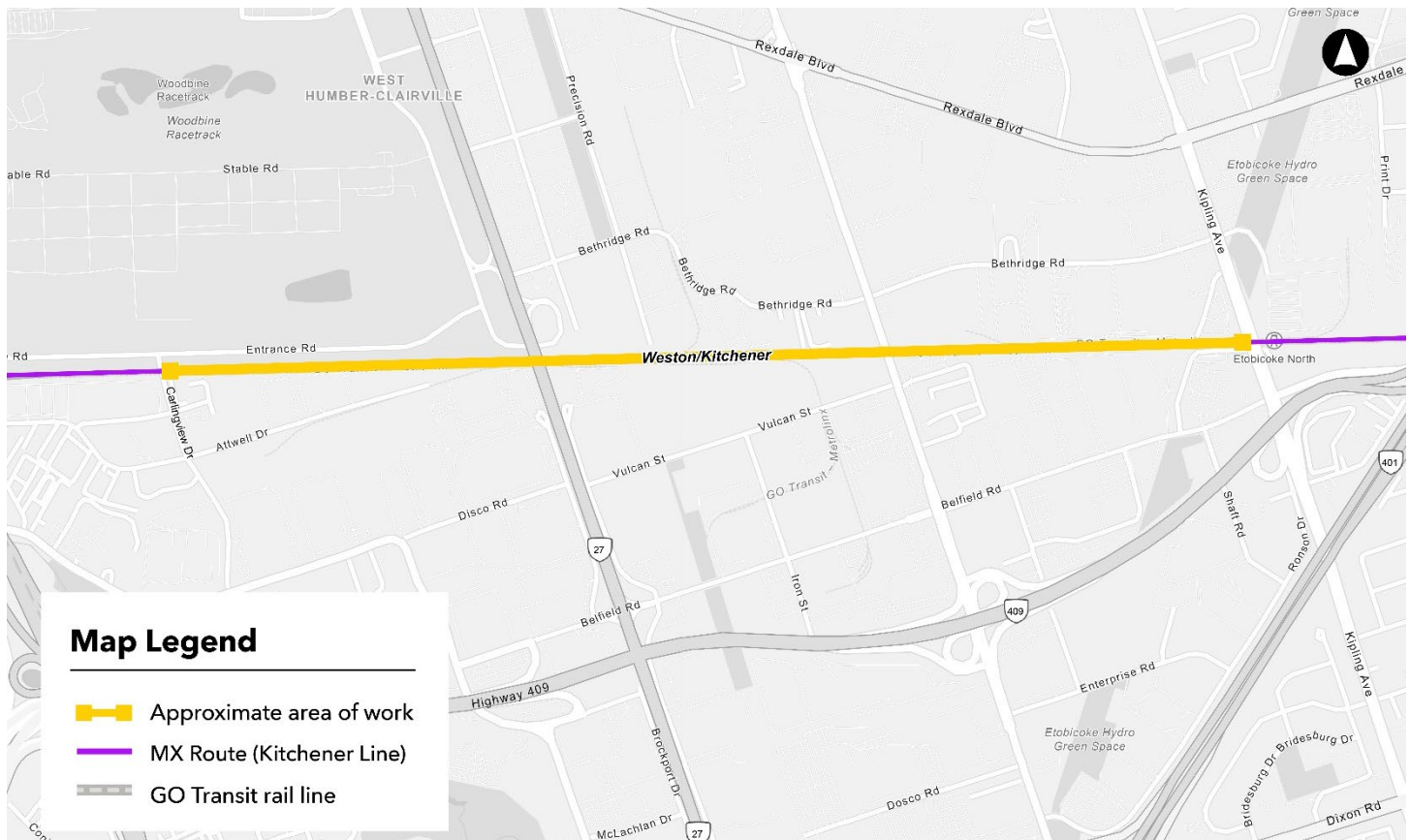


Figure 1: Map depicting work area. Metrolinx image. Not to scale.

What is happening?

Metrolinx has begun early works construction to support Woodbine GO station. As part of this work, Metrolinx will be conducting activities within the rail corridor over a weekend service pause for the Kitchener line. Work will include track asset relocations, track removal and installation, temporary track diversion buildup, ballast works, and welding, among other activities. Work will begin at 9:00 p.m. on Friday, November 7 and will continue, day and night, into the morning of Monday, November 10 at 3:00 a.m.

GO Expansion

GO service is expanding to serve you better - with more frequent service, more stations, cleaner technology, and more connections. Our goal is to deliver more than 10,000 train trips a week across the entire network. You won't need a schedule because you know the next train will be

coming soon. GO Expansion will transform the GO rail network from a commuter service into a two-way, all-day rapid transit network.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- **Noise:** Residents and businesses near the rail corridor may hear noise caused by trucks, heavy equipment and material delivery and other construction equipment required for this work. Work will be conducted quickly and as efficiently as possible to minimize disturbances in the area.
- **Lights:** Lights will be directed into the corridor to minimize light pollution into nearby buildings and businesses.
- **Safety:** To ensure the work is completed safely, Metrolinx will be conducting these activities on the track within the rail corridor during a weekend Kitchener line pause in GO service.

WORK HOURS

- Work will be continuous, day and night, beginning at 9:00 p.m. on Friday, November 7 and completing by Monday, November 10 at 3:00 a.m.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- There will be no GO service along the Kitchener line from the morning of Saturday, November 8 until the morning of Monday, November 10.

TRAFFIC DETAILS:

- No traffic impacts are expected.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- No pedestrian impacts are expected.
