

Bloor-Lansdowne GO: Main Station and Service Building Construction

February 9, 2026 - September 2026*

What Is Happening

Construction is underway at the site of the future Bloor-Lansdowne GO Station. As part of this work, Metrolinx will begin construction of the service building at 17 Dora Avenue (see work zone #1 in Figure 1) and the main station building near 1319 Bloor Street West (see work zone #2 in Figure 1).

Key work activities include site preparation, shoring installation, excavation, foundation installation, and utilities work. The service building will serve operational needs once the station is in service, such as for maintenance and storage, while the main station building will be the primary customer service building for the station, with station attendants and PRESTO services available.

This work will occur Monday to Friday during the daytime, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Construction on the service building will begin on Monday, February 9, 2026, while main station building construction will start on Tuesday, February 17, 2026. Work on both buildings will continue into the summer.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Key work activities include site preparation, shoring installation, excavation, foundation installation, and utilities work.
- Equipment to be used include excavators, loaders, dozers, a roller, and a water truck.
- Noise, dust and vibration: While drilling works will result in periodic noise, dust, and vibration, these impacts will be actively monitored, and every effort will be made to mitigate exposure to nearby residents. No equipment will be left to idle.
- Light: All lights will be pointed down towards the track.

HOURS OF WORK

- Work will occur during the day, Monday to Friday, between 7:00am and 5:00pm.

LOCATION OF WORK

- Work on the service building will occur at 17 Dora Avenue.
- Construction on the main building will be located near 1319 Bloor Street West.

- There will be no impact to private properties.
- Work will occur within the rail corridor.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- No impacts on sidewalks or pedestrian pathways are expected.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- There will be no traffic disruptions.

TRANSIT INFORMATION

- Nearby GO Transit and TTC service will not be impacted.
