

Building demolition by Yonge Street and Steeles Avenue

Expected timeline: as early as mid February 2026 – May 2026

Timing: Weekdays, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. with occasional weekend work



What is happening?

To accommodate future construction of the Yonge North Subway Extension, three buildings at the southeast corner of Yonge Street and Steeles Avenue (6369, 6991, and 6995 Yonge Street) will be demolished. This work is needed to make space for construction materials and equipment needed for tunnelling work and to build the future Steeles Station.

About the Yonge North Subway Extension

The Yonge North Subway Extension will transform the commute in York Region, Toronto and beyond by extending the TTC's Line 1 service north from Finch Station to Vaughan, Markham and Richmond Hill. The project includes five new stations along an extension of roughly eight kilometres.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Work areas will be clearly marked and fenced off before demolition work begins to keep everyone safe.
- You may notice dump trucks and heavy machinery in the area.
- You may experience some noise and vibration from machines, trucks, and other equipment while work is underway.
- Once demolition work is complete, the ground at the site will be filled back in and levelled.
- Measures will be in place to reduce dust, including spraying water and biodegradable dust suppressants.
- Work schedules may change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

PEDESTRIAN ACCESS:

- Sidewalk access on the east side of Yonge Street and the south side of Steeles Avenue may be temporarily affected. Please follow posted signs to navigate safely around work zones.
- Traffic control personnel will be present as needed to safely guide pedestrians and vehicle traffic.

TRAFFIC DETAILS:

- The alleyway behind the work area will be closed for traffic during construction.
- Signage will be posted to redirect pedestrians and traffic.

TRANSIT SERVICE:

- The northbound TTC and York Region Transit bus stops along Yonge Street near Steeles Avenue will be temporarily relocated during this work.
- Signs will be posted at affected stops to direct riders to the new temporary stop locations.
