

## HuLRT and COVID-19







Works included Enbridge, Bell, Rogers, PSN and Cogeco

Completion of all Metrolinx preparatory construction projects anticipated by end of 2020





## **Metrolinx Preparatory Construction Overview**


- ✓ 750m. hydro duct structure built

- ✓ 89% of early works projects complete



#### MOBILIZATION AND TRAFFIC CONTROL SET-UP

1

The area is prepared for removals by placing black and orange cones to divert the traffic due to lane closures.

#### 2 REMOVAL OF CURRENT MEDIAN IN APPLICABLE AREAS OF THE CORRIDOR

A saw cutter is used to remove the medians from the road.

#### 3 MEDIAN PAVING AND RE-INSTATEMENT

Work crews pave and reinstate the roadway with asphalt to complete the process.


