

Bloor Street West Full Closures for Girder Erection

March 29 to April 2, 2022 (Overnight)



What work is taking place?

To complete the girder erection of the west side of the Bloor Street bridge, there will be overnight full road closure between St. Helens Avenue and Ruttan Street. The east half of the bridge will remain open to allow Barrie GO service to continue. **Bloor Street West will be fully closed from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. on Tuesday, March 29 to Saturday, April 2, 2022.**

When

The work is scheduled to take place from Tuesday, March 29 at 6:00 p.m. to Saturday, April 2 at 6 a.m.

Where

The work will take place at the bridge that spans Bloor Street West at the GO rail tracks, between St. Helens Avenue and Ruttan Street. The work will be carried out directly on and under the bridge.

Hours

6:00 p.m. to 6 a.m. with work occurring overnight.

What to expect

Closures on Bloor Street West between St. Helens Avenue and Ruttan Street will be as follows:

***Full closure of Bloor Street West:** There will be no motorist, cyclist, or pedestrian access. Detours will be in place via Lansdowne Avenue and Symington Avenue to Wallace Avenue and Dupont Street. Through-traffic under the bridge is prohibited. Closure and detour signage will be in place.

Prior to the full night closures alternating lane and sidewalk closures will be in place on March 28 from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Traffic will remain as one lane in each direction, however motorists and cyclists must share the lane.
