

Bus Shelter Relocation at Scarlett Road and Eglinton Ave. West Intersection

The Eglinton Crosstown West Extension (ECWE) is one of four new subway projects that will transform transit in our region; getting people where they need to be better, faster, and easier than today.

WHAT WORK IS HAPPENING HERE?

On August 22, 2022, WestEnd Connectors Construction (WECC), the contractors for the ECWE project, will be performing curb work and adjusting traffic signal lights at the southeast corner of the Scarlett Ave. and Eglinton Ave. West intersection. This work is anticipated to last for up to three weeks.

This work includes:

- Temporarily relocating the 79A bus stop approximately 200m to the northeast side of the intersection.
- Closing the right-turn lane on Scarlett Ave. for the duration of this work. Vehicles will still be able to turn right at the lights.
- Closing one northbound lane on Scarlett Ave. for up to one week. All other lanes will remain open to traffic during this work.

HOURS OF WORK

- Construction crews will work Monday to Friday between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Lanes will reopen outside of these working hours.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Nearby residents can expect to hear noise such as drilling from equipment for a short period of time during the day.

TRAFFIC AND PEDESTRIAN IMPACTS

- WECC is working closely with Metrolinx and the City of Toronto to ensure the impact to traffic along Eglinton Avenue West is as minimal as possible during this short phase of work.

The information provided above is anticipated based on the current construction schedule and is subject to change.
