

# Night Work: Utility Relocations between Pape Avenue and Kennedy Road

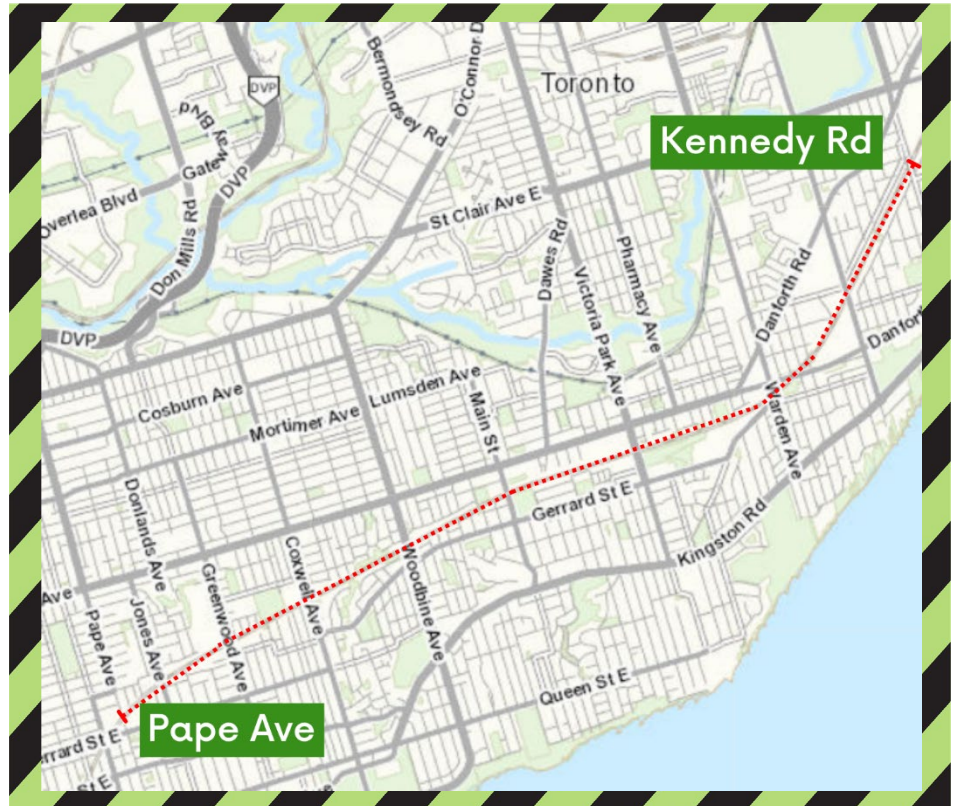
April 2022 to December 2023

## What work is taking place?

The Lakeshore East GO line is an essential corridor for providing utility services we all enjoy and depend on.

To support GO Expansion and the addition of the fourth track for faster, more convenient service, Metrolinx needs to relocate underground utilities within the corridor between Pape Avenue and Kennedy Road.

Utility relocation work is typically short duration and work schedules are often determined on short notice. As such, specific notice for communities is sometimes not possible.



## What to expect:

- Work will be conducted within the railway corridor and involves drilling under the railway tracks, therefore this utility work will occur at night when trains are not running, from 7:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
- Nearby residents can expect to hear noise caused by a vacuum truck.
- The vacuum truck is typically used for one to three days, but sometimes it can remain for up to a week in a given area.
- Following this work is less disruptive work, using hand tools and light trucks.
- This work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
