Schedule "B" Officer Biographies

Annalise Czerny, Executive Vice President, PRESTO

Annalise Czerny has been part of the PRESTO team since 2013, where she worked with senior Metrolinx and provincial stakeholders to build the PRESTO strategy group and program, codify the organization's mandate, create the first business strategy, and articulate a vision for PRESTO's transition from a project focus to a governor of the PRESTO payment scheme. Prior to joining Metrolinx, Annalise worked in strategy consulting for the Monitor Group in the United Kingdom.

Carol Deveney, Principal Sponsor

Carol comes to Metrolinx from Network Rail, where she has held progressively senior roles over the last 12 years, most recently as their Head of Sponsorship (National). Carol holds a record of delivering projects to program, budget and quality specifications such as re-opening of Laurencekirk Station, Airdrie Bathgate Railway and Borders Railway. Carol developed and implemented the first Network Rail Group Standard on sponsorship of projects. At Metrolinx Carol will oversee our corporate transformation to integrate benefits management into decision making.

Carol holds a BA Business and Management, BA Degree Early Childhood Studies and numerous professional certifications including an Associate Certificate in Environmental Management & Assessment (Distinction).

Fawad Ebraemi, Vice President, Operations and Deployment, PRESTO Fawad has been a member of the PRESTO team for more than nine years and has more than 20 years of experience in information technology, operation support services, program management and the transportation industry - in both the public and private sector. Fawad has a Bachelor of Science & Electronics from Polytechnic University of Kabul, a Diploma in Microcomputers and Microprocessors, and a number of certifications and designations including Project Management.

Spencer Gibbens, Head Sponsor

Spencer joins Metrolinx from his role as Principal Programme Sponsor at Network Rail, where he has held numerous Sponsor roles over the last 10 years. Spencer will oversee benefits management and realization of the GO Express Rail expansion program. As Principal Programme Sponsor at Network Rail, Spencer has been accountable for the benefits realization of three major programs (totalling more than \$6B) and the Midland Mainline programme (approximately \$2B). Spencer is an award recipient for Strategic Leadership from Warwick University.

Mathieu Goetzke, Vice President, Planning

Mathieu Goetzke brings more than 17 years of knowledge and experience, with a focus on engineering, urban planning and development, and transportation.
