Bringing Progress Avenue to grade was part of the City of Toronto's Scarborough Centre Master Plan. As part of SSE project, we will be completing this work to support the City's plans for the area.

This work is expected to start in the spring of 2024 and will include a weekend closure at Progress Avenue. This weekend closure is to bring the overpass down. There will be various stages of closures and the timing of this work is expected to begin before construction of the new Scarborough Centre Station. After construction is completed, Progress Avenue will become a permanent 4-way signalized intersection.

There has been some interest in converting the existing SRT structure once it is decommissioned, and this is an initiative that would be led by the City/ TTC. Metrolinx continues to follow up with the City and TTC on the plans for this. The SSE team is aware of this community interest and are working to make provisions in the design at an early stage to allow for a seamless connection between this elevated structure and the subway station

The distance is about 500m east of the existing station to the new location and it's about a 5 min walk from there to the shopping mall. A secondary entrance is being planned on the west side of McCowan Road and Triton Road and will be built through a proposed future development.


Another factor that influenced the location of the new station is the bus terminal. Metrolinx is building a larger bus terminal which requires it to be directly connected to the station
