
Road Closure of Fairview Road West at Hurontario Street

Monday November 7 to Thursday November 17, 2022, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.



What work is taking place?

Construction crews will be installing stormwater infrastructure along Hurontario Street that will also need to cross Fairview Road West. This will result in a closure of a portion Fairview Road at Hurontario Street from November 7-17, 2022. Works are scheduled to take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is also meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work. This work is being done all days including Sundays so crews will be able to complete it safely and efficiently.

During this closure, motorists can access Fairview Road West from Hurontario Street using the detour map provided. Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. If you require the most up-to-date information, please reach out to peel@metrolinx.com.

TIMING

- Fairview Road West will be closed from:
 - o November 7-17, 2022
- Work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. (including weekends)
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Access to Fairview Road West will be maintained through a detour from Hurontario Street and Central Parkway and Joan Drive.
- Access to emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching work zones.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, triaxles, backhoes,

and other construction equipment related to this work.

TRANSIT DETAILS

- MiWay near the intersection will continue to operate with regular service.

- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stop as boarding areas may be relocated.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians as detours may be required.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety
