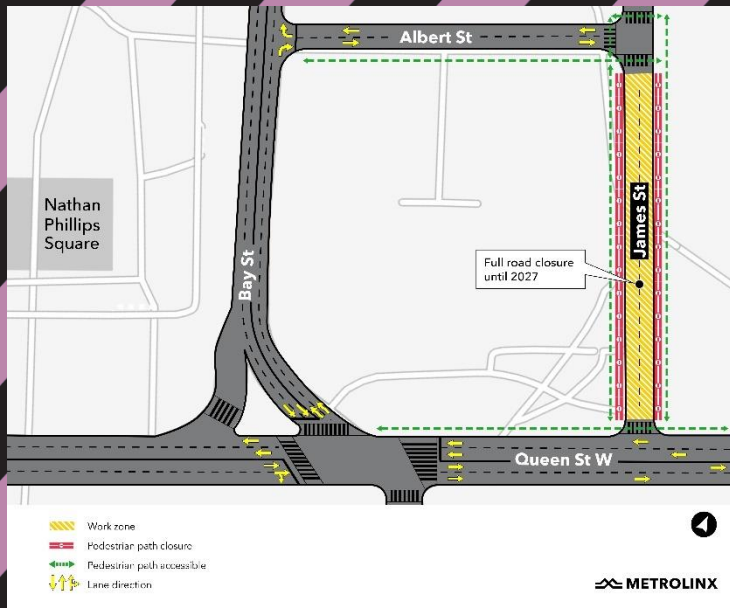


James Street Closure and Utility Relocation

Estimated Start Date: December 12, 2022



What is happening?

Work is underway to deliver the new Ontario Line from the Science Centre to Exhibition Station, to connect more people to more places.

James Street will be closed to accommodate utility relocation work and construction activities below street level. These preliminary construction activities will prepare the site for the future construction of Queen Station.



Timing

- **Estimated Start Date:** December 12, 2022
- **Estimated end Date:** November 2027
- **Days:** 7 Days a week
- **Hours:** 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. for utility work



What to expect

- James Street will be closed to vehicular traffic at the start of the utility relocation and will remain closed until Queen Station is complete in November 2027.
- Deliveries and Wheel-Trans will now need to use Albert Street for access.
- Parking along James Street will be removed.
- While there will be sidewalk closures and pedestrian interruptions, access on James Street will be maintained. Signs, construction fencing, and safety barricades will be in place to direct pedestrians.
- Access to area businesses will be maintained. Businesses near the site can expect to hear noise from the excavators.
- Various noise mitigation methods will be used to ensure that the noise limits set by applicable standards and regulations are met.
- Advanced notice will be provided should there be utility disruptions to surrounding areas.
- The temporary road closure was approved by City Council in December 2021. More information can be found [here](#).
- Construction equipment and the material will be left overnight and properly secured within the work zone.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
