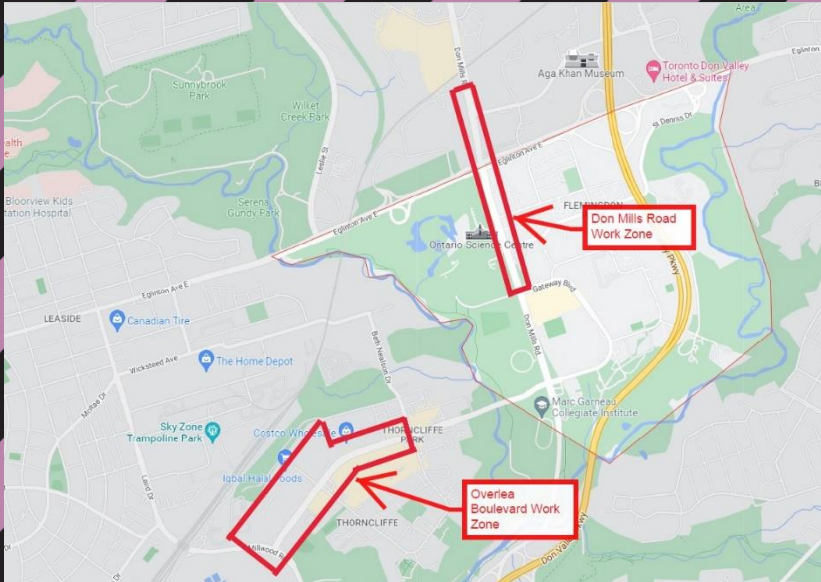


Geotechnical drilling along Don Mills Rd in the vicinity of Eglinton Ave East.

Starting as early as December 12th, 2022



What is happening?

Work is underway to deliver the new Ontario Line from the Science Centre to Exhibition Station to help connect more people to more places.



Timing

- **Scheduled start:** Dec. 12th, 2022
- **Scheduled end:** Feb. 24th, 2023
- **Duration:** Approximately 3 months
- **Day(s):** Monday to Friday
- **Hours:** 9:00 am to 4:00 pm



What to expect

- Crew will use one truck drill and two services trucks, which will generate noise like a vehicle on high idle. Drilling will be advanced every 30 minutes.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by a drill rig, trucks and other construction equipment related to this work. Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Please take care and watch for signs directing pedestrians when walking near construction areas.
- One lane closure at any one time. Traffic will always be maintained in all directions.
- Any impact to pedestrians, traffic or transit will be mitigated by having a Paid Duty Officer or pylons and barricades to redirect traffic.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
