



Land Acknowledgement

METROLINX LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

 - □ Streetscape along Finch Avenue west between Highway 400 and Norfinch/Oakdale


PREVIOUS CLC MEETING Action Items

- TPSS 6 delivery and installation is completed
- The remainder of the systems work to be done in this area are the Toronto Hydro duct banks under Finch Avenue West and connection to a Toronto Hydro pole on North side of Finch
- We anticipate that the civil works around this TPSS site will be completed in Spring 2023
- Paving in the parking lot and TPSS access: Paving to reopen the access road to the TPSS will be done this year. Final paving of the area will be done next year. Access to the hospital property and parking lot remains open

- Assembly and installation of all escalators in Finch West Station




Photo: Newly installed Tobermory platform stop canopies. 2022.11.25

Finch West Station Update

FINCH WEST STATION

Keele Street and Finch Avenue West

- Emergency exit building almost completed
- Main Entrance Building steel structure Completed
- Pedestrian Tunnel backfilling is complete
- All escalators are delivered, and located in place
- Track slab and rail installation almost completed in the portal area and will continue in the west box
- Masonry, Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing, and Architectural works continue
- Systems panels/racks installation continue




Photo: Finch station main entrance escalators and staircase. 2022.11.25


Keele Street to Jane Street

KEELE STREET TO JANE STREET

Keele Intersection

- The new traffic staging at Keele intersection
- To facilitate Finch West Station operations and roadworks west of the intersection
- Will last three months
- Same movements, traffic divided east of Keele

KEELE STREET TO JANE STREET

Keel Street To Jane Street

- All stops' platform have been poured, canopies are installed in Tobermory, Driftwood and Jane stops
- Almost all curbs, sidewalks, bike lanes, and road works completed, final paving to follow based on weather
- Guideway and OCS Poles are complete between Jane Street and Romfield Lane, the work continues at Romfield intersection
- Minor field modifications including bus stops relocation, periodic sidewalk and crosswalk closures may occur to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public
- Paid Duty Officer, flaggers, and detour signs will be used to direct traffic, as needed
- Community members will be notified of any significant construction related impacts, separately

Jane Street to York Gate Boulevard

JANE STREET TO YORK GATE BOULEVARD

- Almost all guideway works including OCS completed
- South side curbs, sidewalks, bike lane, and paving completed, north widening ongoing and boulevard works to follow
- Minor field modifications including bus stops relocation, periodic sidewalk and crosswalk closures may occur to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public
- Paid Duty Officer, flaggers, and detour signs will be used to direct traffic, as needed
- Community members will be notified of any significant construction related impacts, separately



Maintenance and Storage Facility

MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE FACILITY

- Interior and exterior building envelope completed
- Systems testing is ongoing
- Nine trains are delivered to the facility to date
- Nine more trains to be delivered in coming months
- LRV train testing is ongoing inside and, on the guideway

York Gate Boulevard to Weston Road

YORK GATE BOULEVARD TO WESTON ROAD

Norfinch and Signet Drive Intersections

- Final Guideway works ongoing at Signet intersections
- Both intersections to reopen early December starting with Norfinch/Oakdale intersection
- Stops platform concrete pour to be continued for both intersections
- Road widening and boulevard works, including curb, sidewalk, landscaping will continue
- Minor field modifications including bus stops relocation, periodic sidewalk and crosswalk closures may occur to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public
- Paid Duty Officer, flaggers, and detour signs will be used to direct traffic, as needed
- Community members will be notified of any significant construction related impacts, separately



YORK GATE BOULEVARD TO WESTON ROAD

Highway 400 and Finch Avenue West

- Road and guideway work is almost completed
- Multiuse Pathway tunnel installation is completed
- Landscaping is ongoing
- Wet and dry utilities relocation is ongoing
- Periodic ramp closures are probable
- Occasional night work occurs from 6 pm 7 am.
 Additional notices will be provided as needed

Weston Road to Highway 27

Weston Road to Jayzel Drive

- Wet and dry utilities relocation continues at Weston intersection
- Overhead and underground electrical continues
- Median work is scheduled to start in 2023
- Road widening and boulevard works to be continued west of Weston intersection



Jayzel Drive to Islington Avenue

- North curbs and sidewalk works almost completed between Jayzel and Milady, south side is ongoing
- Guideway works continue
- Overhead and underground electrical continues
- Wet and dry utilities relocation, and road widening continue in multiple areas
- Milvan Drive is scheduled to be reopened in late January 2023, approximately
- Milady and Pearldale retaining walls are almost completed
- Guideway works will continue in Winter
- TPSS 4 is installed and duct banks and connection to the LRT line continues
- Rolling plans in place for this area




Islington Avenue Intersection

- Bridge rehabilitation started April 2021 is almost completed
- Guideway works completed on the west side of the bridge and is ongoing for the east half of the bridge
- Islington Westbound stop platform is completed
- Duct banks will be installed below the deck

Islington Avenue to Kipling Avenue

- North Curbs are almost completed
- Guideway works are ongoing and almost completed in many areas up to Farr Avenue bridge
- Rail installation is ongoing
- South road widening and paving is ongoing



Kipling Avenue to Martin Grove Road

- Wet and dry utilities relocation continues at Kipling intersection and will be followed by guideway works
- Guideway installation at Albion intersection has started on the west side and will be completed in 2023
- Roadworks, and guideway installation is ongoing between Kipling Avenue and Martin Grove Road
- Overhead and underground electrical continues
- Traffic is on the south side and north widening is almost completed
- Curbs and sidewalks are ongoing

Martin Grove Road to Highway 27

- Martin Grove intersection guideway works continue on the second half and is scheduled to be completed by late January 2023
- Guideway works is almost completed west of Silverstone
 Drive up to Highway 27 and road works is ongoing
- Curbs, Sidewalks, and bike lane placement is ongoing
- Overhead and underground electrical work continues
- Westmore stop platforms installation is ongoing
- Minor field modifications including bus stops relocation, periodic sidewalk and crosswalk closures may occur to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public
- Paid Duty Officer, flaggers, and detour signs will be used to direct traffic, as needed
- Community members will be notified of any significant construction related impacts, separately

Humber College Station

HUMBER COLLEGE STATION

Highway 27 to Humber College Boulevard

- Almost all utilities relocations, excavation, structural steel and concrete works are completed
- Elevators delivery have been started
- Track slab and rail work is completed in Finch West Avenue portal and continue in Highway 27 portal
- Road works, Mechanical, Electrical, Plumbing and Masonry, and Architectural work continue
- Minor field modifications including bus stops relocation, periodic sidewalk and crosswalk closures may occur to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public
- Paid Duty Officer, flaggers, and detour signs will be used to direct traffic, as needed
- Community members will be notified of any significant construction related impacts, separately

Light Rail Vehicle Testing

LIGHT RAIL VEHICLE TESTING

- Nine vehicles have been received, nine more expected
- Six Light Rail Vehicles (LRVs) have completed high speed testing
- High speed testing (around 60 km/hr) is on going for other LRVs
- Signs are installed to keep residents informed about the closure
- Paid Duty Officer, flaggers, and detour signs will be used as needed
- Notices will be shared, and Community members will be notified of related impacts


