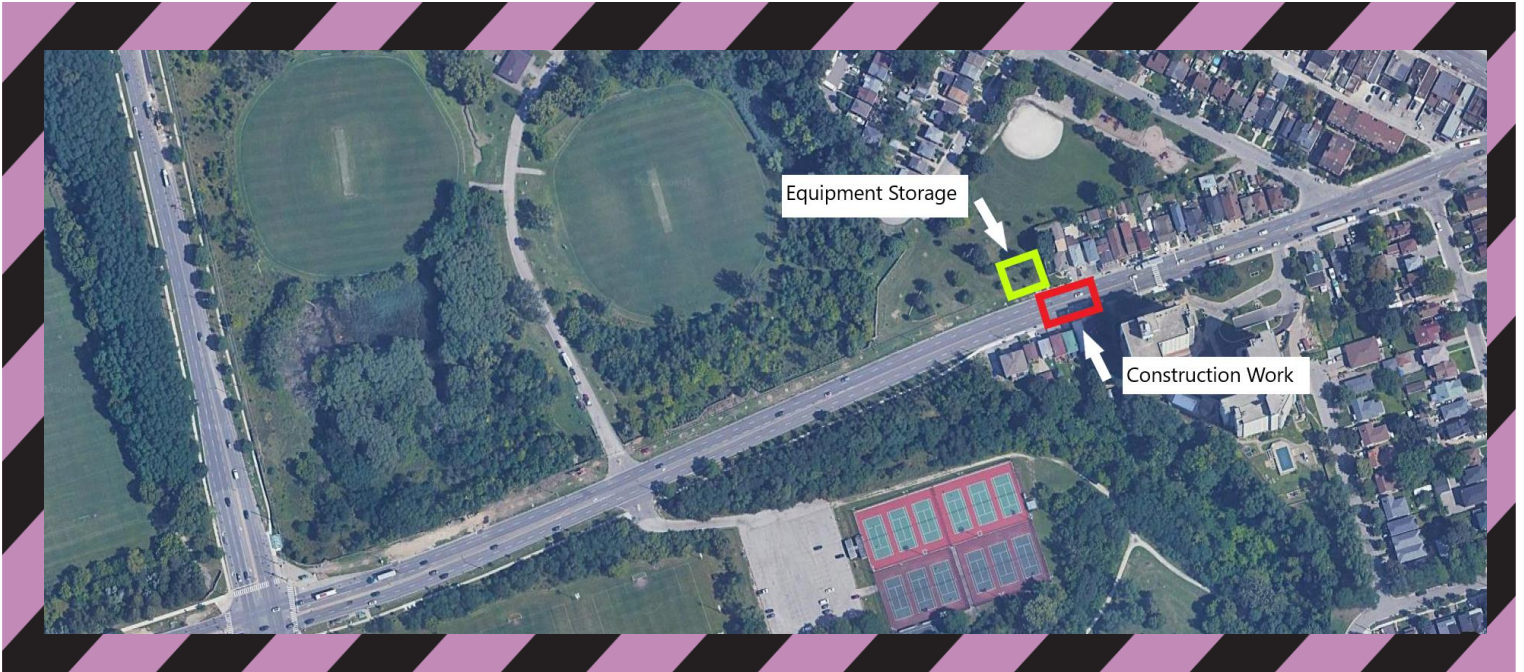


Utility Relocation Along Eglinton Avenue West

December 2022 - March 2023



The Eglinton Crosstown West Extension (ECWE) is one of four new subway projects that will transform transit in our region; getting hundreds of thousands of people where they need to be, better, faster and easier than today.

What work is happening here?

To prepare for upcoming tunnel construction, workers from Toronto Hydro will need to relocate utilities along Eglinton Avenue West between Pearen St. and Jane St. on Eglinton Ave. W. to meet infrastructure requirements for the ECWE project.

Phase 1: Temporary power service at the Jane portal

- Between now and February 28, 2023, Toronto Hydro will cut open Eglinton Avenue West adjacent to Pearen Park to install concrete duct structures and construct the switch foundation.
- This work will be conducted at Eglinton Ave West between Jane St. and Pearen St.

Phase 2: Cable chamber rebuild

- Starting this month through to the end of March, 2023, Toronto Hydro will rebuild the roof of the existing cable chamber and relocate the access frame and cover it from its current position.
- As a part of the cycle track works, the existing manhole chamber will be relocated
- This work will occur at the South East corner of Jane St. and Eglinton Avenue West

HOURS OF WORK

- All utility work will be done under the supervision of Toronto Hydro.
- Work can occur between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m, Monday to Friday.
- Work may be rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Utility relocation work will be done using a drilling method called horizontal directional drilling, which is a faster and cleaner method compared to digging trenches.
- Residents nearby can expect to see and hear the machines in the work zones described above.
- In addition to construction activity, residents can expect to see equipment and material storage across the street, north of where work will be completed (refer to map).

TRAFFIC AND PEDESTRIAN IMPACTS

- There may be some temporary, short term lane reductions to ensure safe work sites. Information regarding limitations of when or what lane reductions will occur will be provided.
