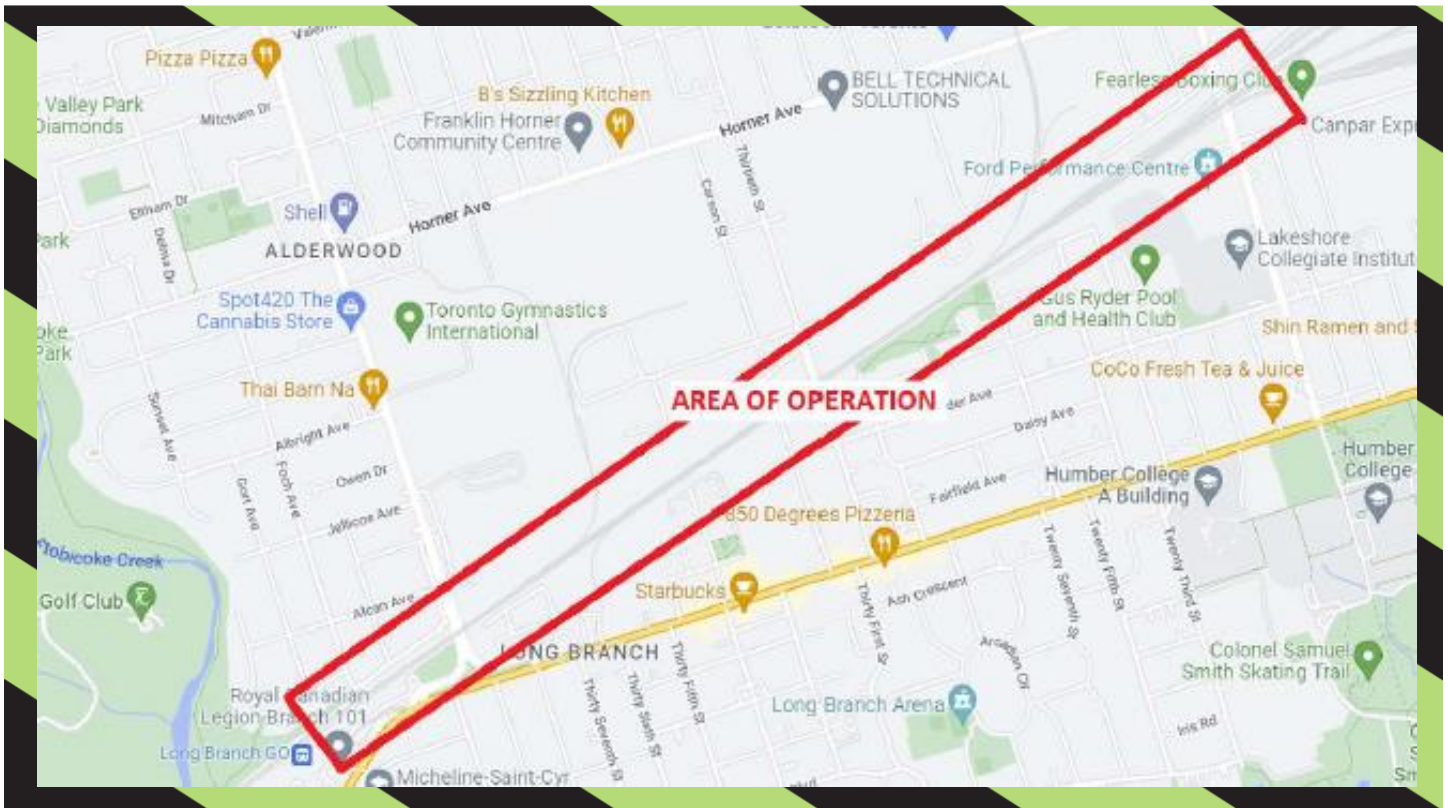


# Aerial Survey Operation within the Lakeshore West Corridor, Long Branch - Nov 18 to Nov 22

## Project Overview

Work is underway to deliver the GO Expansion Program - the largest transit expansion in Canadian history. GO Expansion will transform the GO network from a commuter service to a new all-day, all-direction, schedule free travel option. More than a rush hour commuter service, GO will offer more service with faster trains, more stations and seamless connections to a regional rapid transit network.

The Lakeshore West GO expansion will expand your possibilities. With 15-minute service or better throughout the day between Toronto and Burlington, alongside new hourly service to and from Hamilton seven days a week, you'll have more ways to get where you need to go.

## What is Happening?

As part of investigative work for the GO Expansion project, a Remote Piloted Aircraft (RPAS/Drone) will perform aerial surveys along the Lakeshore West rail corridor. The drone will capture images and data for pre-engineer design mapping. This survey will support the design of future track and infrastructure updates.

## Hours of Work

The survey is expected to take place between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. November 18 to November 22, 2022. **Work may be rescheduled or extended due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.**

## What to Expect

The drone will be flown over the rail corridor between the limits of Kipling Avenue and Long Branch Station within the rail corridor and laydown facility. There will be staff on-site conducting and monitoring the operation.

## Traffic & Pedestrian Details

No impacts to traffic or pedestrian routes are anticipated during this work.

## Transit Information

No impacts to public transit are anticipated during this work.
