
The Ontario Line

件 Timing

- Scheduled start: January 17, 2023
- Estimated completion: February 12, 2023
- Days: Monday to Friday
- Hours: Approximately 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

🖈 What to expect

- Work crews will be in the area to conduct survey work, that involves capturing 3-D scans of area buildings.
- Buildings scheduled for survey are near the future Ontario Line station sites at Exhibition, King-Bathurst, Queen-Spadina, Osgoode or Queen.
- This work is being completed to capture the dimensions and specifications of buildings as part of construction planning and design.
- The survey works will be mainly done in the interior of buildings. When scanning the exterior of buildings, the survey crew will use a scanner mounted to a tripod on the sidewalk.
- Equipment will not be left on site outside work hours.
- There are no expected impacts to pedestrians, cyclists, or traffic.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.
