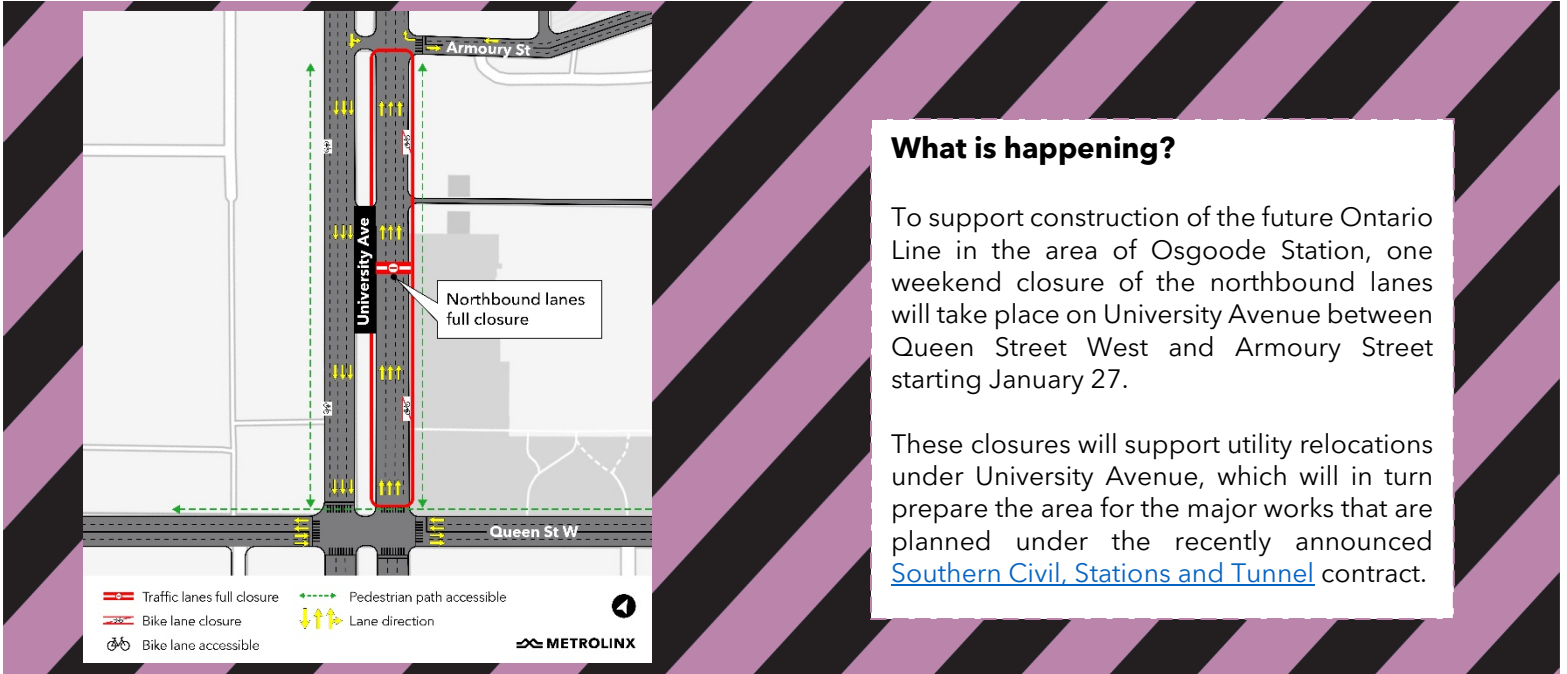


Weekend closure: University Avenue northbound lanes (Queen Street to Armoury Street) for utility relocation

Starting January 27, 2023



What is happening?

To support construction of the future Ontario Line in the area of Osgoode Station, one weekend closure of the northbound lanes will take place on University Avenue between Queen Street West and Armoury Street starting January 27.

These closures will support utility relocations under University Avenue, which will in turn prepare the area for the major works that are planned under the recently announced [Southern Civil, Stations and Tunnel](#) contract.

Timing

- **Scheduled Work**

Date:

Friday January 27 at 7 p.m. to Monday January 30 at 6 a.m.

- **Hours:**

Friday 7 p.m. to Monday at 6 a.m.

What to expect

- This closure will take place on the weekend of January 27-30, 2023.
- The closure will take place from Fri. at 7 p.m. to Mon. at 6 a.m.
- Detour signage will be posted in advance to direct drivers to adjacent northbound streets.
- The northbound bicycle lane will be closed during the work hours; detour signage will be posted to re-direct cyclists.
- Safety barricades will be in place to prohibit drivers, cyclists, and pedestrians from entering the work area.
- While sidewalks will remain open, some minor sidewalk impacts can be expected periodically throughout the work. There will be signs, construction hoarding, and safety barricades to direct pedestrians around the impacted sidewalk as needed. Pedestrian access will be maintained.
- TTC streetcar and subway access will be maintained.
- A paid duty police officer will be onsite to assist with traffic control as needed.
- There will be no restrictions to emergency vehicles. One lane will remain open through the work zone to allow for emergency vehicles.
- Construction equipment and material will be left overnight and properly secured within the work zone.
- All required permits will be obtained to carry out this work.
- Businesses near the site can expect to hear noise from the excavators.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
