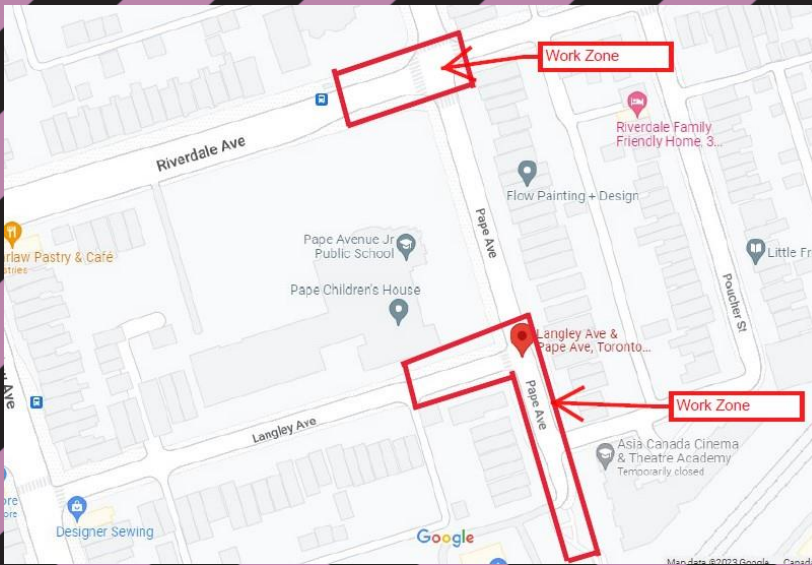


Water level monitoring in the Pape and Langley area

Starting as early as January 27, 2023



What is happening?
 MetroInx will be using hand tools and trucks to measure ground water levels. Using this information, MetroInx can determine the construction approach for the Ontario Line project.



Timing

- **Scheduled start:** January 27, 2023
- **End Date:** February 12, 2023
- **Days:** Weekends
 - January 27 and 28
 - February 4, 5, 11 and 12
- **Hours:** 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.

What to expect

- Crew will be using hand-held tools and trucks to measure ground water levels and collect samples to gather information and evaluate underground conditions.
- The work is non-intrusive and is not expected to impact traffic nor pedestrians.
- There will not be any impacts to sidewalks.
- Drums will be used to store any excess water and will be properly labelled. Drums will be removed at the end of every shift.
- Please take care and watch for signs directing motorists near construction area.
- Expect truck to be parked onsite during work hours. Truck and equipment will be removed from site at the end of each shift.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
