

Drilling in Thorncliffe Park Garden Club community garden

Starting as early as February 2, 2023



What is happening?
 Work crews will be drilling into the ground in the Thorncliffe Park Garden Club community garden and sampling groundwater to gather information and evaluate underground conditions. This information will be used to help inform design and construction plans for the northern part of the Ontario Line.



Timing

- **Drilling work:**
Weekdays from February 2 to 7, 2023
- **Groundwater sampling:**
Once a week from February 13 to May 13, 2023
- **Hours:**
8 a.m. to 5 p.m.



What to expect

- Work crews will drill a borehole inside the Thorncliffe Park Garden Club community garden at Beth Neilson Drive. Then they will return weekly to sample groundwater from the borehole. This will help inform design and construction plans for a new bridge that will carry subway trains across the Don Valley.
- **There will be no impacts to garden plots for this work.** Crews will use the existing access road to access the borehole site.
- During drilling work, people nearby may hear hammering sounds and noises similar to a vehicle idling on high.
- Some equipment will be left onsite, including drums containing groundwater and soil. Equipment will be removed when work is complete.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to unforeseen weather conditions.
