Maple GO Upgrades

- A renovated east platform.
- A new and upgraded west side platform.
- A north and south tunnel (including elevators) to connect to the west platform.
- Expanded bus loop on Eagle Rock Way and a north tunnel connection to the bus loop.
- Upgraded Passenger Pick-Up, Drop-Off zone.
- A new pedestrian bridge over Major MacKenzie Drive.
- Noise wall along the west side of the corridor from Rutherford Road to McNaughton Side Road.
- New retaining walls, pathways, and landscaping around the bridge.

What is happening?

Storm line improvements near Maple GO will be taking place over the next 8-12 months but will be mostly within the corridor.

The installation of a noise barrier wall along the west side of the corridor between Major MacKenzie Drive and McNaughton Road will begin in 2023.

What does this mean for you?

You may experience additional noise and dust in the area, but every effort will be made to minimize any impacts. We apologize for the inconvenience.

What is the timing and duration?

This work will take place on weekdays from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm.
