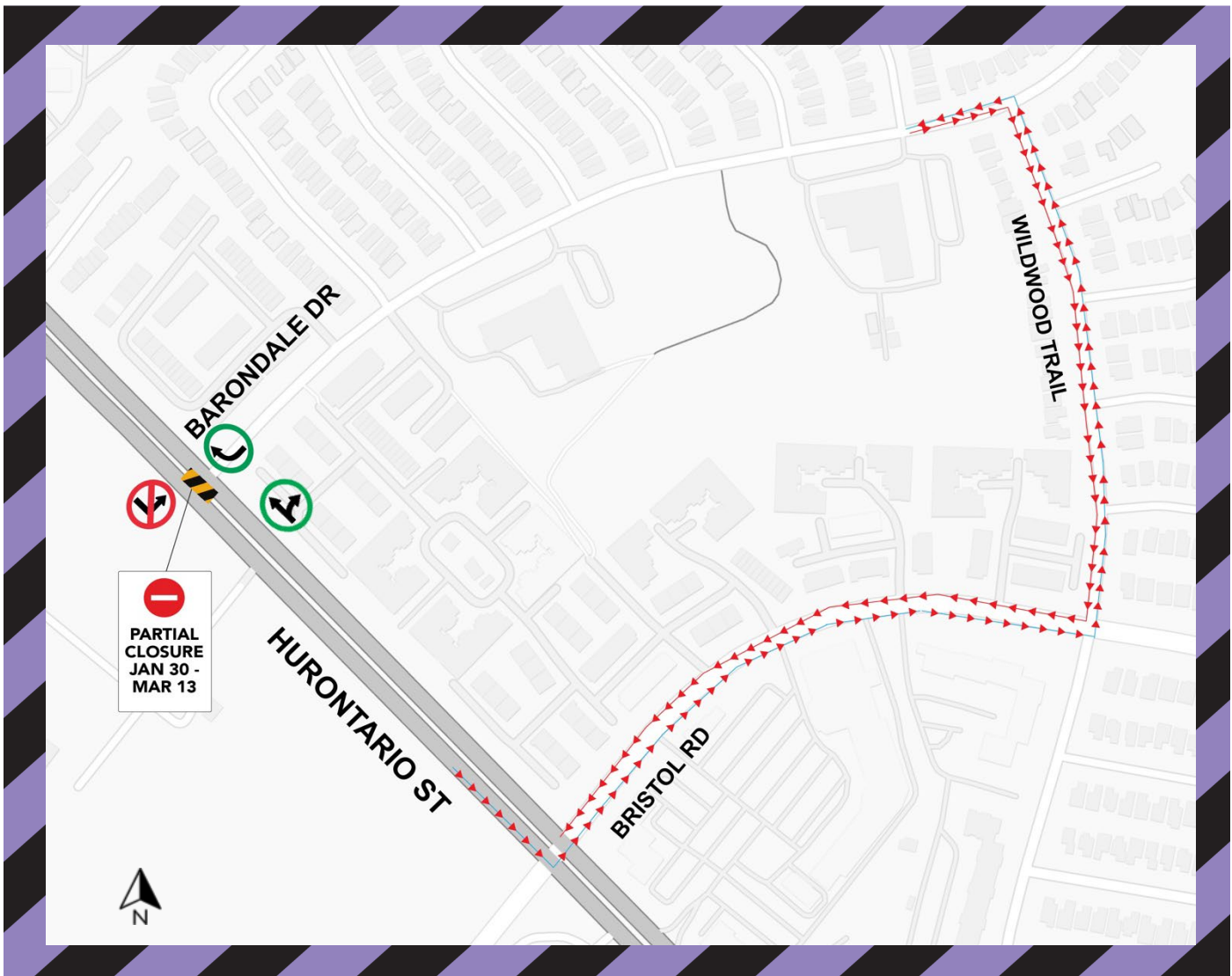


Partial Intersection Closure for Track Installation at Barondale Drive and Hurontario Street

Monday January 30, 2023 at 10 p.m. to Monday March 13, 2023 at 10 p.m.



What work is taking place?

Important work to install tracks along Hurontario Street continues, requiring a left-turn restrictions at the intersection of Barondale Drive and Hurontario Street. Crews will be excavating the centre of the intersection to install tracks and pour concrete, enabling the guideway to move through intersections along Hurontario Street. The closure will take place from **Monday January 30, 2023, at 10 p.m.** until **Monday March 13 2023 at 10 p.m.** Detour routes will be accessible via Wildwood Trail and Bristol Road.

Construction work at this intersection is scheduled to take place from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. until completion. Overnight work is expected on the first day so crews can safely setup stage the construction working area. Access for emergency vehicles across Hurontario Street will not be maintained. Traffic signal timings will be adjusted to keep people moving. Pedestrian crossings will be maintained at a signalized crosswalk. Please follow the signs installed to assist with navigating around the closure.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axes, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. If you require the most up-to-date information, please reach out to peel@metrolinx.com and our team will provide you with e-updates of this work.

TIMING

- Work at Barondale Drive and Hurontario Street is scheduled from January 30, 2023 until March 13, 2023.
- Construction is scheduled to occur from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Left turns from Barondale Drive onto Hurontario Street will not be permitted.
- Left turns from Hurontario Street onto Barondale Drive will not be permitted.
- Access for emergency vehicles across Hurontario Street will not be maintained.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Temporary traffic signal heads will be bagged to align with the lane closures.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

TRANSIT IMPACT DETAILS

- Bus stops will be maintained.
- Visit MiWay.ca and Brampton.ca for updates on your bus route.

- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas may be relocated.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Access to properties will be maintained.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when walking or cycling near construction areas and watch for additional signs directing the public such as detours and dismounting.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians across Hurontario Street as only one east/west crosswalk will be provided at all Hurontario Street intersections.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.
