Early upgrades at Finch Station

Scheduled start: February 2023

Timing: Weekdays from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

What is happening?

 Work is underway on early upgrades to get Finch Station ready for major construction of the Yonge North Subway Extension. Much of the work will happen along Hendon Avenue as upgrades are made to the electrical infrastructure that will bring power to the new subway extension.

What to expect

- 48 parking spaces in the TTC parking lot on Hendon Avenue will be closed.
 - Construction materials and equipment will be stored within a fenced area.
- Access to Finch Station and the pickup/drop-off area will be maintained.
- Safety barricades will be in place and signage will be posted to caution and direct drivers, cyclists and pedestrians.
- Lane configurations may change as work progresses.
- A paid duty police officer will be present as needed to assist with traffic control.
- Noise and vibration from construction vehicles and equipment will be monitored and kept within guideline limits and regulations.

Starting late February

 Construction on a new, temporary exit from the parking lot to Talbot Road will begin. A temporary traffic signal will be installed at Talbot Road and Hendon Avenue.

Starting in March

- The new temporary parking lot exit to Talbot Road will open.
- The Hendon Avenue parking lot exit will be closed.
 - The Hendon Avenue parking lot entrance will remain open.
- Lane closures on Hendon Avenue from Yonge Street to Duplex Avenue.
- Left turns onto Yonge Street from Hendon Avenue will be restricted.
- Right turns from Yonge Street to Hendon Avenue will be prohibited.
- The north-south crosswalk on the west side of Yonge Street at Hendon Avenue will be closed.
 - Pedestrians can cross on the east side of Yonge Street.
- The bus stop near the northwest corner of Yonge Street and Hendon Avenue will be temporarily moved approximately 30 metres north.

About the project

- The Yonge North Subway Extension will transform the commute in York Region, North York and beyond by extending the TTC's Line 1 service north from Finch Station to Vaughan, Markham and Richmond Hill.
- When it goes into service after the Ontario Line is complete, the extension will make it faster and easier for more people to travel between York Region and downtown Toronto while cutting down on traffic congestion and pollution.
