
Upcoming tree removals along Langley, Riverdale and Pape Avenues

Timing

- Scheduled work date: As early as March 11, 2023
- Completion date: Approximately March 31, 2023
- Days: Weekends
- Hours of work: Approximately 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

What to expect

- To prepare for the future Ontario Line, existing utilities will need to be relocated along Pape Avenue.
- To accommodate this work, six trees will be removed within the area shown on the image above.
- There will be one (1) tree removed along Langley Ave., on the weekend of March 11, 2023. The tree is centrally located at the south easterly most entrance to the playground.
- The remaining five (5) trees will be removed on the weekend of March 18, 2023, with work expected to be completed by March 31, 2023.
- Where required, crews will install barriers around nearby trees that are being protected and preserved.
- Metrolinx has a Vegetation Guideline that specifies how many trees need to be planted when any tree is removed, ranging from 1 to 50 new trees based on the size and location of the tree being removed. Our practice is to plant at least three trees for every single tree removed as we build more transit across the Greater Golden Horseshoe.
- Metrolinx will work closely with the City of Toronto and Toronto and Region Conservation Authority on replanting trees in the area, where possible. Learn more at <u>metrolinx.com/vegetation</u>.
- There will be signage and flag persons on site to help direct pedestrians safely.
- Access to residences in the area will be maintained throughout the duration of the work.
- All necessary permits will be obtained prior to work commencing.
- The work start date could be rescheduled or delayed due to weather conditions or any unforeseen circumstances.
