Partial Intersection Closure for Track Installation at Topflight Drive and Edwards Boulevard

Monday March 13, 2023 at 7 p.m. to Monday April 10, 2023 at 7 p.m.



What work is taking place?

Important work to install tracks for the Hazel McCallion line continues, requiring restrictions at the intersection of Topflight Drive and Edwards Boulevard. Crews will be excavating the corner of the roadway at the intersection to install tracks and pour concrete to construct the LRT guideway. This will enable the light rail vehicles to move between Hurontario Street and the Operations Maintenance and Storage Facility (OMSF). Left-hand turns from Topflight Drive onto Edwards Boulevard, as well as right-hand turns from Edwards Boulevard onto Topflight Drive, will be guided by a one-way (single lane) bi-directional signal.

During this process, motorists will be prohibited from making right-hand turns from Topflight Drive onto Edwards Boulevard. As well, left-hand turns will not be permitted from Edwards Boulevard onto Topflight Drive. In addition, northbound and southbound through-traffic on Edwards Boulevard, at Topflight Drive, will not be permitted.

The partial closure will begin on Monday March 13, 2023, at 7 p.m. until Monday April 10, 2023 at 7 p.m. Construction on following days at this intersection is scheduled to take place from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., seven days per week until completion. Detour route to Edwards Boulevard will be accessible via Derry Road. Access for emergency vehicles through the intersection of Topflight Drive and Edwards Boulevard will be reduced to the same traffic restrictions. Traffic signal timings will be adjusted to keep people moving.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work. Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. TIMING

- Work at Topflight Drive and Edwards Boulevard is scheduled from March 13, 2023 until April 10, 2023.
- Construction is scheduled to occur from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., seven days a week.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Right-hand turns from Topflight onto Edwards Boulevard will not be permitted.
- Left-hand turns from Edwards Boulevard onto Topflight Drive will not be permitted.
- Northbound and southbound through-traffic on Edwards Boulevard at Topflight will not be permitted.
- Access for emergency vehicles at the intersection of Topflight Drive and Edwards Boulevard will be reduced to follow traffic restrictions.
- Traffic from Topflight Drive to Edwards Boulevard will be guided by a temporary two-way bi-directional traffic signal. Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

TRANSIT IMPACT DETAILS

- Visit MiWay.ca and Brampton.ca for updates on your bus route.
- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas may be relocated.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Access to properties will be maintained and we will work directly with the properties where driveways closures are required and access will be maintained through at least one driveway where applicable.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when walking or cycling near construction areas and watch for additional signs directing the public such as detours and dismounting.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.
