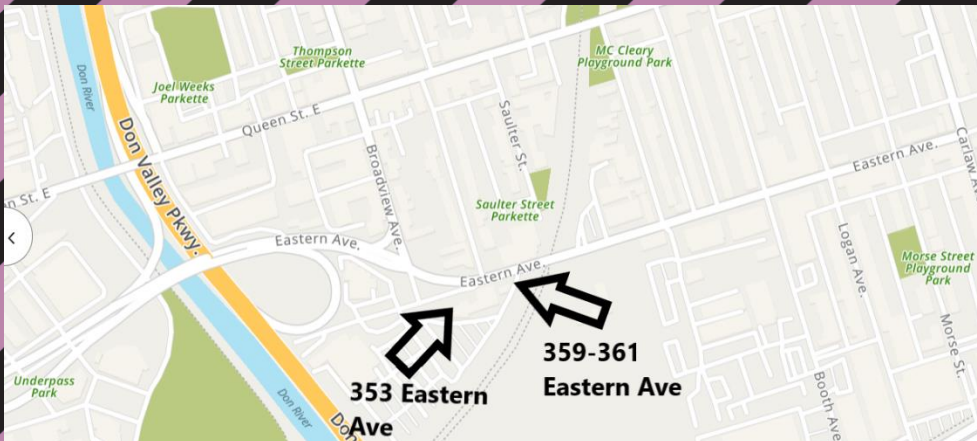


Upcoming Building Demolitions – Safety hoarding to be installed at 353, 359-361 Eastern Avenue

Starting as early as March 20, 2023.



What is happening?

To prepare for construction of the future Ontario Line, properties are needed for access to the rail corridor and construction areas for the widening of the Eastern Avenue bridge.



Timing

- **Scheduled work date:** As early as March 20, 2023
- **Completion date:** July 2023
- **Days:** Monday-Friday
- **Hours of work:** 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.



What to expect

- The buildings to be demolished will be vacant and the property will be surrounded by safety hoarding that will be secured in place.
- Work will start with utility disconnections, interior demolition, followed by exterior demolition.
- Waste bins will be at the site and removed/replaced as required.
- Sidewalks will remain open with overhead canopy protection.
- If needed, temporary lane occupancy on Eastern Avenue will follow the City of Toronto's permitting process, including the use of Paid Duty Officers as required.
- Residents can expect to hear some typical construction noise and vibration while work is taking place.
- Any equipment left on site will be always secured within the site hoarding area.
