


# Road realignment and extraction shaft construction update

Scheduled start: April 2023

Timing: From 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m.

## What is happening?

- The road realignment of Eglinton Avenue West, just west of Scarlett Road, will be completed in April 2023. Crews will reopen the newly constructed traffic lanes, pedestrian sidewalk and the ramp to the pedestrian bridge.
- With this work on the south side of Eglinton now complete, construction of the extraction shaft will begin on the north side of the newly realigned traffic lanes.
- The extraction shaft is where the tunnel boring machines will be dismantled and removed from the ground once tunnelling is complete. The shaft is also the portal for where the vehicles go between the underground and aboveground sections of the line.
- This phase of construction is anticipated to complete in fall 2023.

## What to expect

- Nearby residents can expect to hear noise from equipment, such as drilling, compaction equipment, hauling trucks, excavators, dozers and generators.
- Work will be coordinated with the City of Toronto to ensure the impact to traffic and residents along Eglinton Avenue West is minimal.
- The Richview Road driveway is currently scheduled to remain open for residents during this construction.

- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances, and occasional weekend or overnight work may be required.

## Traffic and Pedestrian Impacts

- Three lanes will be open to traffic on Eglinton Avenue West between the pedestrian bridge and Scarlett Road: two lanes eastbound and one lane westbound. Turning movement at Scarlett Road and Eglinton Avenue West will remain the same.
- Bus stop #73 at the northwest corner of Scarlett Road and Eglinton Avenue West will be temporarily relocated 90 metres north.
- The sidewalk on the north side of Eglinton Avenue West will be temporarily closed between the pedestrian bridge and Scarlett Road. Pedestrians are advised to use the south sidewalk on Eglinton Avenue West as an alternate path.
- Please pay close attention to the traffic and pedestrian signage during construction.

## About the project

- The Eglinton Crosstown West Extension will bring even more rapid transit to Etobicoke and Mississauga, making it easier for people to get where they need to be each day.
- The extension of the Eglinton Crosstown LRT will run 9.2 kilometres from Mount Dennis Station to Renforth Drive and will operate mainly underground. Once complete, it will create a continuous rapid transit line that stretches from Scarborough, through midtown Toronto, and into Mississauga.
