Investigative work at the intersection of Pape Ave and Riverdale Ave

Starting as early as April 10, 2023



What is happening?

Work is underway to deliver the new Ontario Line from the Science Centre to Exhibition Station to connect more people to more places.

Metrolinx will be using a hydrovac truck and hand-held equipment to gather information and evaluate underground conditions. Using this information, Metrolinx can determine the construction approach for this project.



Timing

- Scheduled start: April 10, 2023
- Day(s): One day
- Hours: Approximately 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.



What to expect

- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear some noise caused by truck and other construction equipment.
- Work crews will be conducting test pits and utility investigation to evaluate ground conditions and determine the position of subsurface utilities.
- This work will involve the use of hand-held equipment as well as well as a Hydro-Excavation truck.
- To identify locates, there will be some paint markings and staking.
- The crew will do their best to keep the dust impact low by adding water when performing saw cuts.
- Crews will always maintain one lane of traffic throughout the duration of the work. A paid duty officer will be on site to redirect traffic.
- Pylons and barricades will be set up to provide barriers between pedestrians and cyclists, and traffic.
- All necessary permits have been obtained.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
