

Construction at Sheppard Avenue East and McCowan Road

Scheduled start: Early April 2023

What is happening?

- Tunnelling is now underway for the Scarborough Subway Extension.
- Work needs to be completed on the southeast corner of Sheppard Avenue East and McCowan Road for tunnelling.
- Construction activities will include relocating some utilities, drilling and concrete pouring.

What to expect?

- Work is expected to begin in early April 2023 and should be completed by mid-June 2023.
- Major works will mostly take place seven days a week, between 6 a.m. to 7 p.m., with additional, quieter work overnight.
- Noise and vibration from construction vehicles and equipment will be monitored and kept within guideline limits and regulations.
- The equipment that is used on site will also include sound absorber pads to dampen noise.
- Work areas will be clearly marked or fenced off as required to ensure public safety.
- There may be temporary sidewalk closures or pedestrian detours in place while the work is underway. Please take care when travelling near work sites.
- Work may be delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

About the project

- The Scarborough Subway Extension will bring the TTC's Line 2 subway service nearly eight kilometres farther into Scarborough, helping to reduce travel times and improve access to jobs, schools and other key destinations throughout the city.
- It will extend from Kennedy Station to Sheppard Avenue and McCowan Road, with three new stops at Lawrence and McCowan, Scarborough Town Centre and Sheppard and McCowan.
