
Lane Reductions at Derry Road and Hurontario Street

Begining the week of April 17, 2023, to June 13, 2023



What work is taking place?

Crews will be welding tracks and doing concrete work for guideway installations within the intersection of Hurontario Street and Derry Road. Work will begin on the north half of the intersection. When completed, crews will shift staging over to the south half of the intersection. During this process, east-west traffic along Derry Road will be reduced to single lanes in each direction. All left turns will also not be permitted. Detour route is available via Hurontario Street and Longside Drive/Admiral Boulevard. Work is scheduled to begin at the north half of Derry Road as early as **Tuesday April 18, 2023, at 10pm, until Tuesday May 16, 2023, at 10pm,** followed by works on the south half of Derry Road on **Tuesday May 16, 2023, at 10pm, until Tuesday June 13, 2023, at 10pm.**

Construction work at this intersection is scheduled to take place 12-24 hours per day, until completion. Access for emergency vehicles across Hurontario Street along Derry Road will be maintained. Traffic signal timings will be adjusted to keep people moving. Pedestrian crossings will be maintained at a signalized crosswalk. Please follow the signs installed to assist with navigating around the closure.

Transit services will be impacted by these temporary intersection closures. Please visit www.miway.ca/updates, www.brampton.ca/transit and gotransit.com for updates on your bus route.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TIMING

- Intersection work is scheduled to begin as early as April 18, 2023, until June 13, 2023
- Construction is scheduled to occur from 12-24 hours per day, 7 days per week.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Eastbound and westbound movements will be reduced to a single lane in each direction.
- Lefthand turns at Derry Road and Hurontario Street will not be permitted.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, tri-axles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TRANSIT DETAILS

- Visit MiWay.ca, Brampton.ca and gotransit.com for updates on your bus route.
- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas may be relocated.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Please take care when travelling near construction areas.
- Sidewalk access in the area could be affected.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians as detours may be required.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.

PROPERTY DETAILS

• Crews will not require property access for this work.
