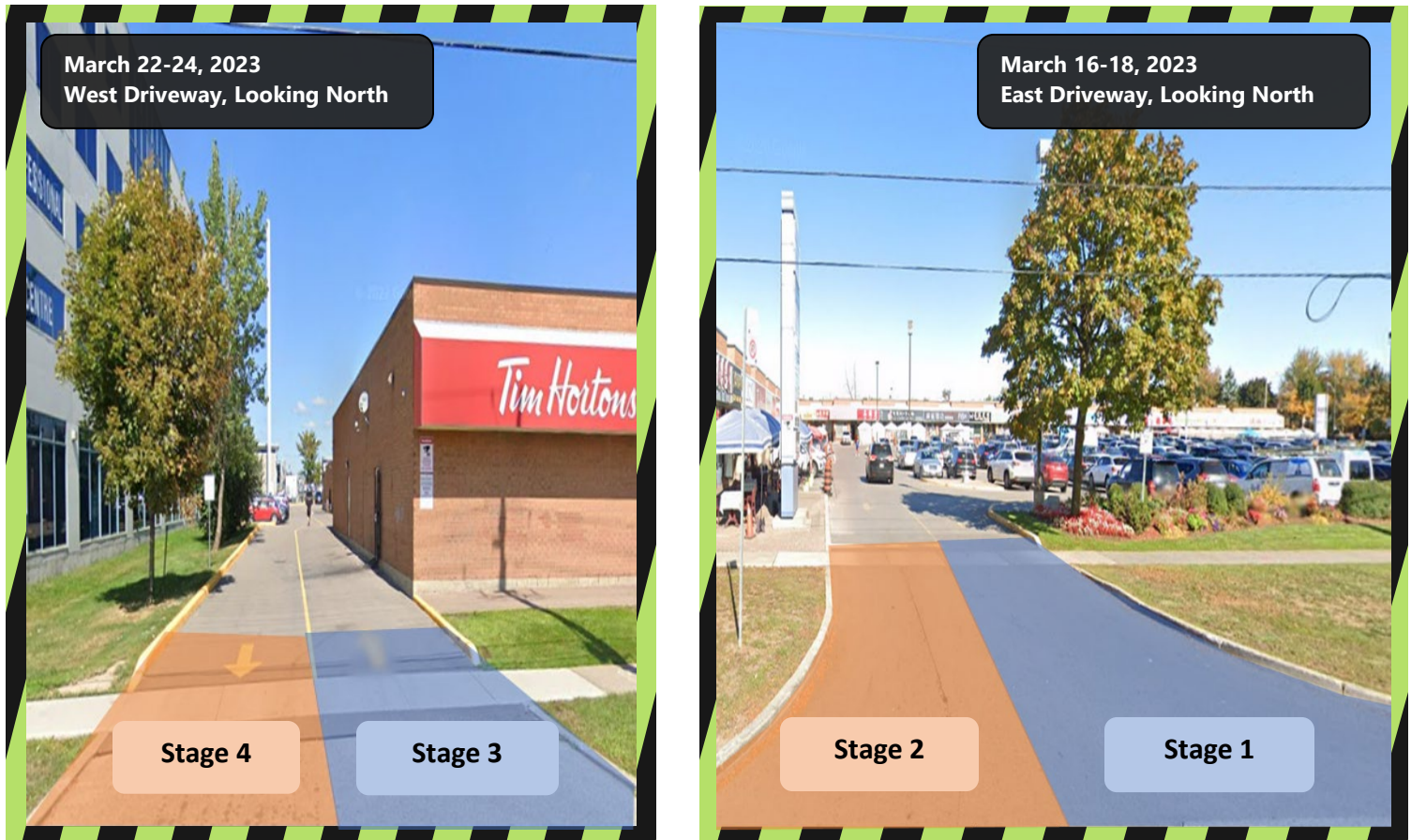


Partial Closures of Driveway Access at 4186 - 4190 Finch Avenue East

March 16-18, 2023 & March 22-24, 2023



Photographs show the staged partial closures of the east driveway (Mar 16-18) and the west driveway (Mar 22-24) of 4186 - 4190 Finch Avenue West.

What You Need to Know

Crews will be working in the City of Toronto right of way on Finch Avenue East. In order to complete important utility relocations, there will be staged partial closures of both the east and west driveways to 4186-4190 Finch Avenue East.

Partial closure of the east driveway will be between March 16-18, 2023 and partial closure of the west driveway will be between Mar 22-24, 2023. During work, crews will be working in stages, blocking only one side of the driveway at a time. Each stage will take 1-2 days to complete. Each driveway will take 3 days to complete. Once complete, full access to the driveways will be restored.

SmartTrack Finch Kennedy GO Station

SmartTrack is bringing five new GO stations to Toronto, leveraging roughly 40 km of Metrolinx's pre-existing GO rail corridors within Toronto. The new SmartTrack Finch-Kennedy GO Station will be located on Finch Avenue East between Milliken Boulevard and Midland Avenue, on the Stouffville GO rail corridor.

Work Details

- Crews will be digging an open trench across each driveway.
- Work is being completed in 4 stages in order to maintain access to the Finch-Midland Centre from Finch Avenue East.
- After each stage of work, the trench will be back-filled and the driveway will reopen.

Location

- Work is taking place in the City of Toronto right of way, in front of 4186- 4190 Finch Ave East, which is the Finch-Midland Centre.

Timing

- East Driveway March 16 to March 18, 2023:
Stages 1 and 2, completed in 3 days.
- West Driveway March 22 to March 24, 2023:
Stages 3 and 4, completed in 3 days.
- Working hours are from 7 am to 5 pm

Traffic Details

- Vehicles will still be able to access the Finch-Midland Centre from Finch Avenue East.
- Driveway access to the property from Midland Ave will not be affected.
- A traffic control person will be on site when crews are working to guide vehicles in and out of the property.

Pedestrian Details

- The sidewalk on the north side of Finch Avenue East will be partially closed.
- A traffic control person will be on site when crews are working to guide pedestrians in and out of the property.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained to ensure pedestrian safety.

What to Expect

- Access to properties will always be maintained with the assistance of a Traffic Control Person.
- Residents and businesses should expect some noise, vibration, dust, and site lighting
- Work areas will be safely delineated.
- There will no interruption to any City services during construction.
