

Possible overnight works at Scarlett and Eglinton Avenue West

Scheduled start: May 8, 2023

Timing: From 7:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.

What is happening?

 WestEnd Connectors Construction (WECC), the contractors for this project, will be completing paving/asphalt work near the pedestrian bridge, just west of the Scarlett Road and Eglinton Avenue West intersection.

What to expect

- Construction crews will work between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m., however, overnight work may be required to complete this activity.
- WECC is making all efforts to complete this work within the designated construction hours. This work is required to reopen lanes and minimize traffic impacts during rush hour the following morning.
- Nearby residents can expect to hear noise from equipment, such as drilling, compaction equipment, hauling trucks, excavators, dozers, and generators.
- WECC is working closely with Metrolinx and the City of Toronto to ensure the impact to traffic and residents along Eglinton Avenue West is as minimal as possible during this phase of work.
- The information provided above is anticipated based on the current construction schedule and is subject to change.

About the project

- The Eglinton Crosstown West Extension will bring even more rapid transit to Etobicoke and Mississauga, making it easier for people to get where they need to be each day.
- The extension of the Eglinton Crosstown LRT will run 9.2 kilometres from the Mount Dennis station to Renforth Drive and will operate mainly underground. Once complete, it will create a continuous rapid transit line that stretches from Scarborough, through midtown Toronto, and into Mississauga.
