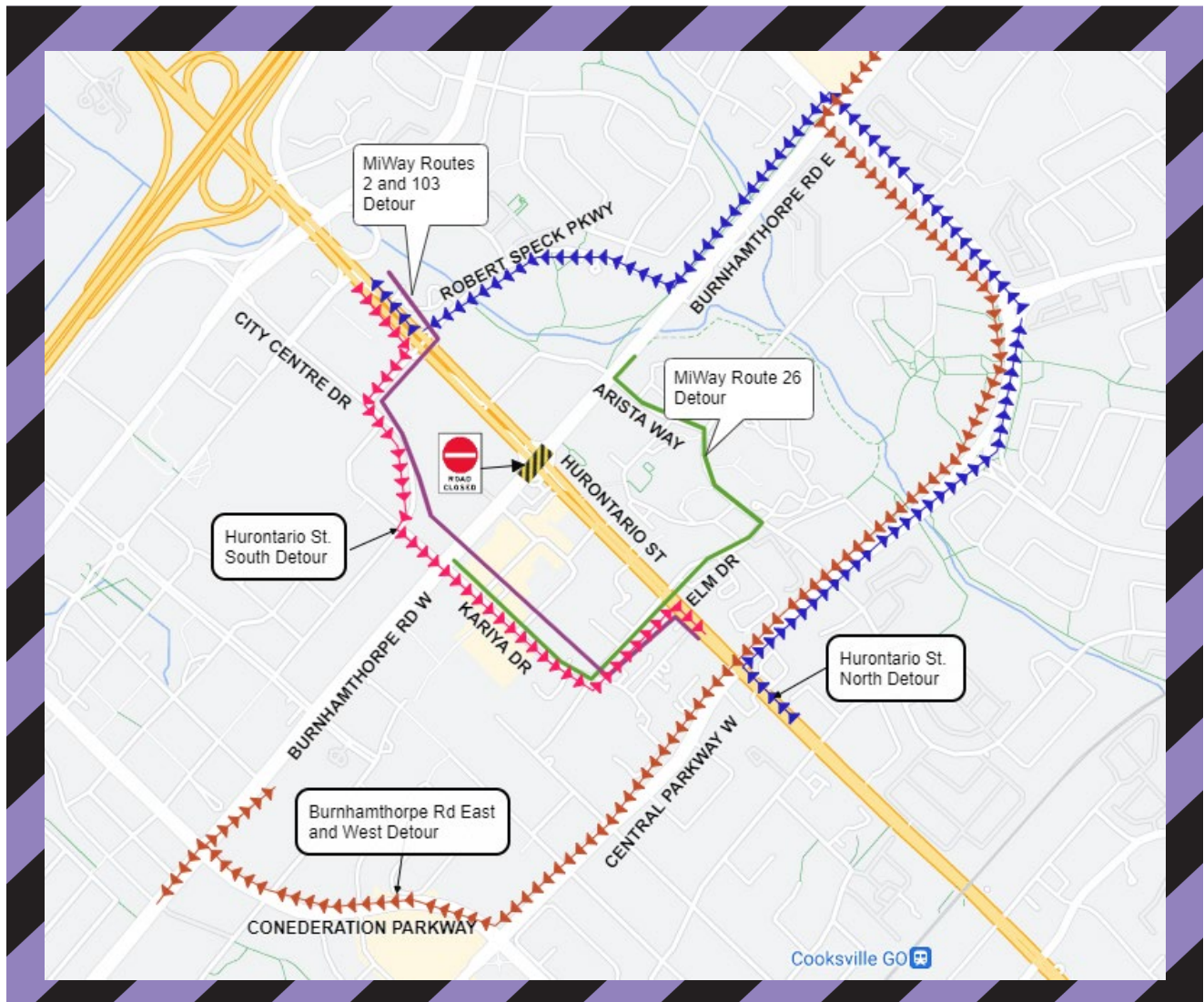


Intersection Closure of Hurontario Street and Burnhamthorpe Road

Friday May 26 at 7p.m. to Monday May 29, 2023 at 6a.m

Works are scheduled to take place 24 hours a day



What work is taking place?

To accommodate major utility relocations, crews will be required to close the intersection of Hurontario Street and Burnhamthorpe Road on Friday, May 26 at 7p.m., reopening on Monday, May 29 at 6 a.m. Works are scheduled to take place 24 hours a day to ensure work can be completed safely and efficiently.

Please follow posted detour signs while navigating around the intersection closure. Detours routes include Robert Speck Parkway, City Centre Drive, Kariya Drive, Elm Drive, Confederation Parkway, Central Parkway, and Arista Way. Access for emergency vehicles will not be maintained during the closure. Traffic signal timings will be adjusted to keep people moving, but traffic delays are expected. Pedestrian crossings will be impacted at Burnhamthorpe Road and Hurontario Street, please follow the signs installed to assist pedestrians with navigating around the intersection closure. Access to businesses will remain open.

MiWay routes 2, 26 and 103, and GO Transit's route 21C will be detoured during this closure. Please visit www.miway.ca/updates or gotransit.com for updates on your bus route.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

Please note, work may be rescheduled due to weather or unforeseen circumstances. If you require the most up-to-date information, please reach out to peel@metrolinx.com and our team will provide you with e-updates of this work.

TIMING

- Work is scheduled to start from May 26, 2023, at 7 p.m. to May 29, 2023, at 6 a.m.
- Works are scheduled to take place 24 hours a day.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Please follow signs for detour routes which are also shown on the map.
- Traffic delays are expected.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, loaders, triaxles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.

TRANSIT IMPACTS DETAILS

- Visit www.miway.ca/updates or gotransit.com for information on your bus route. MiWay routes 2, 26 and 103, and GO Transit's route 21C will be detouring around the intersection of Hurontario Street and Burnhamthorpe Road.
- Watch for additional signs directing passengers at bus stops as boarding areas will be relocated.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

- Sidewalk access in the area could be affected.
- Watch for additional signs directing pedestrians as detours may be required.
- Clear and defined walking paths will be maintained during construction to ensure pedestrian safety.
