# Lakeshore West Rail Corridor Maintenance - Bridge Rehab

June 2023 – November 2023



## What You Need to Know

Starting in early June, Metrolinx will be undertaking bridge maintenance along the Lakeshore West (LSW) rail corridor. We will be repairing and rehabilitating the **Parkside Drive Bridge**, **Colborne Lodge Drive Bridge**, **Ellis Avenue Bridge**, **Windermere Avenue Bridge and the South Kingsway Bridge** between the Queensway & Lakeshore Blvd W. <u>Work will be taking place on 1 or 2 of these structures concurrently.</u>

Work includes sandblasting, coating of the structures (except Parkside), steel and concrete repairs, and waterproofing repairs. We have worked with the City to develop a traffic control plan that maintains one lane of traffic in each direction where the work will occur. Some overnight work will also occur, however we will make the necessary efforts to reduce community impacts. We understand that we are conducting rail maintenance in residential areas along the rail corridor, and that overnight work is not ideal. We appreciate your patience and





we will complete this work as efficiently as possible to get things back to normal for you. The timeframe of work is subject to change based on work progress.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT

- Anticipated overnight work for bridge rehab and maintenance.
- Overnight work is necessary so trains can run throughout the day.
- Lane closures.
- Noise levels may be elevated in the areas surrounding the work locations.
- You may see lights so workers can opeprate safely at night. Our teams always work hard to minimize community impacts.
- Work on these structures is expect to take 6 months, working at 1-2 locations simultaneously, however work schedules are subject to change.

### HOURS OF WORK

- Majority of work will take place during the day between 7am and 11pm.
- Overnight on weekends from Friday night to Monday morning.
- Maintenance work that impacts rail service is being completed during the night time to avoid disruption to the Lakeshore West GO Trains.
- Productivity each night varies depending on a variety of factors such as weather.

### TRAFFIC DETAILS

- There are anticipated lane closures at all locations.
- Traffic will be reduced to single lane traffic where work is occurring.
- Please review traffic signs and drive with care in areas of work.

#### PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

• There are no anticipated pedestrian impacts.

#### TRANSIT INFORMATION

- There are no anticipated transit impacts. Trains will operate as scheduled throughout the day. Train schedules may vary based on service changes.
- Work will be completed within the LSW Rail Corridor.
- There are no anticipated TTC impacts.
