


Figure 1: Map showing the closure of westbound lanes, reducing traffic to one lane in each direction.

WHAT WORK IS TAKING PLACE?

In preparation for and to facilitate the demolition of the Eastern Avenue rail bridge, short-term lane closures will be required. During all stages of work outlined below, a single lane of traffic in each direction and sidewalk access will be maintained.

THE SMARTTRACK EAST HARBOUR TRANSIT HUB

The new East Harbour Transit Hub will be located just east of the Don River and north of Lakeshore Boulevard East, in the Riverdale neighbourhood. This interchange station, on the Lakeshore East GO line, will provide seamless connectivity to more GO services, the future Ontario Line, and the TTC Broadview streetcar, in a corner of the city that is poised for growth. It will also divert some of the commuter traffic away from Union Station, as the East Harbour Transit Hub, will be an alternate station for transferring between transit lines and services.

- Access to driveways will be maintained.

- Work area will be safely delineated.
