

Nightworks Between Harborn Road and Dundas Street

Monday June 12 to Friday June 30, 2023

Works are scheduled to take place from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m.



What work is taking place?

As utility upgrades progress in the area, crews will be installing Alectra electrical duct banks at the intersection of Hurontario Street and Dundas Street during the nights from **June 12-21, 2023**. The work hours are 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. on each night Monday to Saturday. The work will be completed in three phases with one corner of the intersection at a time. Some temporary lane closures which will require motorists to detour during construction along with sidewalk closures required during this work. The impacted lanes will be re-opened with steel plates during the day. Bus stops will be relocated, please watch for signage. Please follow pedestrian and traffic signage at all times.

Construction crews will also be working on Hurontario Street from Harborn Road to King Street to pave the roadway. This work will take place from **June 14-16, 2023**. The work hours are 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Residents can expect to hear noise from scrapers, grinding and construction vehicles on these nights.

Finally, crews will be installing stormwater pipes and Alectra electrical duct banks at Hurontario Street Bronte College Court during the nights from **June 19-30, 2023**. The work hours are 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. on each night Monday to Saturday. Some temporary lane closures will be required during this work during the night. Please follow detour signage. Access to the hospital parking lot and Bronte College will be maintained during these works.

All works are being done overnight so crews will be able to complete them work safely and efficiently while minimizing impacts. In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work. Please note, work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.

TIMING

- Nightworks are schedule at Dundas Street and Hurontario Street June 12-21, Monday to Saturday.
- Nightworks for paving are scheduled on the nights of June 14-16 on Hurontario Street between Harborn Road and Paisley Boulevard.
- Nightworks are scheduled at Bronte College Court and Hurontario Street from June 19-30, 2023, Monday to Saturday.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Temporary lane closures at night. Please follow detour route signage.
- Emergency access will be maintained.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching work zones.

WHAT TO EXPECT?

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators,

loaders, tri-axles, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work.
