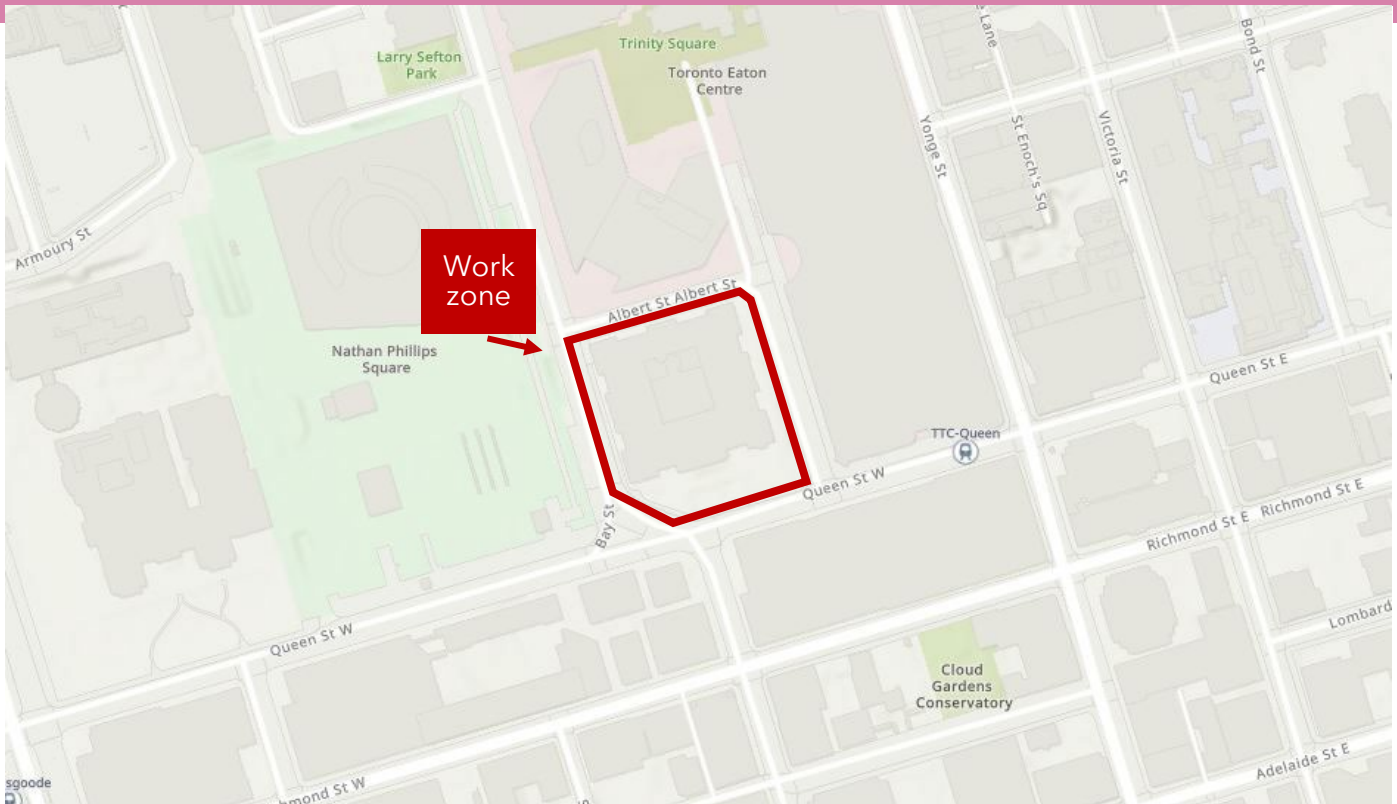


Noise and vibration monitoring work at Old City Hall

Expected start: Tuesday, June 6, 2023

Expected duration: **7 months**



What's happening?

- Work is underway to deliver the long-awaited Ontario Line, a new 15.6-kilometre subway line that will run from Don Mills Rd and Eglinton Ave, all the way to Exhibition Place, with 15 stations along the way.
- A crew of 1-2 persons will be on site to install noise and vibration monitors. This is necessary as it provides an understanding of existing levels that will be compared to levels during construction. Also, this information will be used to help with the creation and implementation of mitigation measures.

What to expect

- Crews will be using hand-held devices including tripod, data logger, noise monitor, microphone and vibration monitor to carry out this work.
- There will be no impacts to sidewalks, driveways, or residential properties for this work.
- Set up of the monitoring equipment will take approximately 1-2 days, and removal will take approximately 1-2 hours.
- Equipment maintenance will take place at an ad-hoc basis for a maximum of 1 hour per occurrence
- All necessary permits have been obtained.
- After the monitoring period is complete, all equipment associated with the baseline monitoring program will be removed from the site.
- Work may be delayed or rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.
