Land Acknowledgement

Finch West Station

FINCH WEST STATION

- Structural and masonry works are completed
- Duct bank, track slab, and rail installation are completed
- Architectural works including, flooring, ceilings, and interior and exterior claddings are ongoing
- Curtain walls are on the final stage
- Installation of elevators and escalators continue
- Mechanical, electrical and plumbing continue
- Systems panels/racks/devices installations continue



Keele Street to Jane Street

KEELE STREET TO JANE STREET

- Guideway is almost complete
- Curbs, sidewalks, bike lanes, and road works are almost complete with two lanes in each direction
- All stops' concrete platform, systems cabinet and canopies are complete
- Permanent traffic signals on Sentinel Drive and Driftwood Avenue intersection installed, Tobermory Drive intersections to follow
- Final utility and road works are ongoing on the south side at Keele intersection
- Field modifications may occur to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public
- Paid Duty Officers, flaggers, and signs will be used to direct traffic and improve safety as needed
- Community members will be notified of any significant construction-related impacts, separately

Maintenance and Storage Facility

MAINTENANCE AND STORAGE FACILITY

- Interior and exterior building envelope complete
- Systems testing is ongoing
- Light Rail Vehicle (LRV) delivery continues
- LRV testing is ongoing on the guideway and inside the facility

Jane Street to Weston Road

JANE STREET TO WESTON ROAD Jane Street to Signet Drive

- Guideway works are almost complete in this area
- North Boulevard works between Jane Street and York Gate Boulevard is ongoing
- Norfinch stop, and Signet eastbound stop canopies are installed, Signet westbound to be installed in late June early July
- Multi-Use Pathway tunnel installation is complete
- Permanent traffic lights are installed on the east ramps of Highway 400 intersections
- Final dry utility and boulevard works continue




Photo: Norfinch Oakdale stop east side of Norfinch Drive and Oakdale Road intersection. 2023.05.27

YORK GATE BOULEVARD TO WESTON ROAD Signet Drive to Weston Road

- Wet and dry utility relocation is ongoing
- Guideway duct bank pours completed, track slab continue
- Field modifications may occur to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public
- Paid Duty Officers, flaggers, and detour signs will be used to direct traffic and improve safety as needed
- Community members will be notified of any significant construction-related impacts, separately
- Occasional night work occurs from 6 pm 7 am



Weston Road to Highway 27

WESTON ROAD TO HIGHWAY 27 Weston Road to Jayzel Drive

- Utility works continue between Weston Road to Jayzel Drive
- Weston Road intersection guideway works are scheduled to start in June after completion from east side of the intersection
- Weston Road stops concrete works are scheduled to be started in June

WESTON ROAD TO HIGHWAY 27 Jayzel Drive to Islington Avenue

- North and south road widening is almost complete, while curbs and sidewalk works continuing
- Duct banks and track slab completed, rail installation continue
- Wet and dry utility relocation continues in multiple areas
- Milvan eastbound platform concrete works completed while westbound platform continue
- Duncanwoods eastbound canopies installed, westbound to follow
- Pearldale platforms concrete pours started
- Rolling traffic plans are in place for this area

WESTON ROAD TO HIGHWAY 27 Islington Avenue Intersection

- Bridge rehabilitation started in April 2021, and is almost complete
- Guideway works completed for the bridge, and northbound and southbound lanes are open
- Islington westbound stop platform completed with canopies installed, eastbound platform concrete works continue
- Rail installation for the bridge is planned for late June

WESTON ROAD TO HIGHWAY 27 Islington Avenue to Kipling Avenue

- North widening, sidewalk and curbs are almost complete
- South widening will be started mid June, south sidewalk and curbs to follow
- Guideway works including excavation, duct bank, track slab, OCS bases and poles are almost complete
- Rail installation is ongoing
- Kipling stop's concrete platform on the east side of Kipling is complete

WESTON ROAD TO HIGHWAY 27 Kipling Avenue to Martin Grove Road

- Guideway works between Kipling Avenue and Highway 27 are almost complete, rail installations continues
- Martin Grove, Stevenson and Kipling stop's concrete pours are complete, while Albion westbound stops are ongoing
- Stevenson and Martin Grove stop canopies installed, Kipling and Albion to follow
- Remaining widenings, curbs and sidewalks are ongoing between Kipling Avenue all the way to Martin Grove Road on both sides and different locations
- Noise walls on the east side of Kipling to be competed by mid June
- New entrance road to Albion mall has started, roadworks ongoing

WESTON ROAD TO HIGHWAY 27 Martin Grove Road to Highway 27

- Between Martin Grove Road intersection to Humber College Station guideway works are complete
- Westmore Drive permanent traffic lights installed
- Telecom, streetlight, and traffic light works continue in multiple locations, with minimal impacts to traffic
- Remaining boulevard works including widening, curbs, sidewalks, and bike lanes continues for the area and all intersection
- Field modifications may occur to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public
- Paid Duty Officers, flaggers, and signs will be used to direct traffic and improve safety as needed
- Community members will be notified of any significant construction-related impacts separately

Humber College Station

HUMBER COLLEGE STATION Highway 27 to Humber College Boulevard

- Utility, excavation, structural, masonry, aluminum cladding, and curtain wall works are completed in the Humber College Station, while rail and OCS works continue
- Parking paving and curbs are in final stages
- Covered walkway canopies installation and landscaping started and will continue in June
- Architectural work and elevator assembly are ongoing
- Mechanical, electrical, and plumbing work are ongoing
- Systems panels/racks/devices installations continue
- Field modifications may occur to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public
- Paid Duty Officers, flaggers, and signs will be used to direct traffic and improve safety as needed
- Community members will be notified of any significant construction-related impacts separately



Light Rail Vehicle Testing

LIGHT RAIL VEHICLE TESTING

- Seventeen vehicles have been received, one more expected
- Last LRV delivery is scheduled to be completed in June
- Light Rail Vehicles (LRVs) testing continue in "Burn-In" area
- Signs are installed to keep residents informed about road closures
- Paid Duty Officers, flaggers, and detour signs will be used to direct traffic and improve safety as needed
- Notices will be shared, and community members will be notified of related impacts
