What work is taking place?

As the improvements to Mary Fix Creek and the Eaglewood Bridge structure near completion, construction crews will be working at night to complete final paving activities on the bridge as well as in the north parking lot at Port Credit GO Station. These works will allow for the handover of additional parking spaces for GO customers and bring us closer to the commissioning of a more efficient traffic connection across Hurontario at Eaglewood.

To complete the work, crews will be onsite between the hours of 5 p.m. and 12 a.m. tonight. Once paved, crews will continue to work this weekend to clean up the area and perform line painting in the parking lot. In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks backing up, and other construction equipment related to this work. We understand that we are building in a residential area and that night work is not ideal. We appreciate your patience and will complete this work as efficiently as possible to get things back to normal for you.

- Night work will take place on June 22, 2023, between the hours of 5 p.m. to 12 a.m.
- Work could be rescheduled and delayed due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- This work is in the north portion of the Port Credit parking lot, directly adjacent to Mary Fix Creek as well as at the new Eaglewood Bridge structure.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching lane reductions.

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
- Residents and businesses near the work site can expect to hear noise caused by trucks beeping to back up and other construction equipment related to this work.
