

Groundwater sampling at 227 Bay Thorn Drive

Scheduled Work Period: June 27-29, 2023

Timing: 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

What is happening?

Technicians working on behalf of Metrolinx will be taking samples of groundwater at 227 Bay Thorn Drive to assess the environmental conditions at the property.

About the Yonge North Subway Extension

The Yonge North Subway Extension will transform the commute in York Region, Toronto and beyond by extending the TTC's Line 1 service north from Finch Station to Vaughan, Markham and Richmond Hill. The extension includes five confirmed stations along an extension of roughly eight kilometres.

OVERVIEW

- Field technicians will be collecting groundwater samples for laboratory analysis.
- The samples will provide information about the chemical profile of the groundwater which will inform plans for future construction activities at this site.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Technicians will be on site at 227 Bay Thorn Drive between June 27 and June 29 to purge the existing well and take samples.
- The purged water will be stored in a drum at 227 Bay Thorn Drive and removed by July 11 by a contractor.
- Noise during this work will be limited to a battery powered pump.

METHODOLOGY

- Groundwater samples will be manually taken from the existing monitoring well using hand tools like Allen keys, screwdrivers, and a bailer device. A battery-powered pump may also be used.
- Before collecting the samples, the well will be purged using plastic tubes and a valve.
