# What work is taking place?

Crews will be installing Alectra duct banks at the intersection of Hurontario Street and The Queensway during the nights from Monday July 17 to Monday August 7, 2023. The work hours are 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. on each night including weekends.

Some temporary lane closures will be required during this work. The impacted lanes will be re-opened with steel plates during the duration of this work. There will also be turn restrictions in place. Please follow detour signs. This work is being done overnight so crews will be able to complete this work safely and efficiently while minimizing impacts.

In accordance with City of Mississauga Noise By-Law Exemption requirements, this notice is meant to advise that residents near the work site can expect to hear noise and vibration caused by trucks, excavators, backhoes, and other construction equipment related to this work. Please note, work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances.

# TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Temporary lane closures and left turn restrictions will be required at this intersection.
- Emergency access will be maintained.
- Watch for slow moving vehicles entering and exiting work areas.
- Remember to reduce your speed when approaching work zones.

- Every effort will be made to minimize disruptions.
