
Daytime Road Milling Works and Overnight Paving and Line Painting Works - Eglinton Avenue West between Oriole Parkway and Lascelles Boulevard

What Work is Taking Place?

As early as Wednesday, July 12, 2023, crews at Avenue Station will be performing road milling, paving, and line painting works on Eglinton Avenue between Oriole Parkway and Lascelles Boulevard. Milling works will take place daily between 7:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. Paving and line painting works will take place overnight between 8:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. To complete milling, paving, and line painting works safely, periodic lane reductions will be in place on Eglinton Avenue

between Oriole Parkway and Lascelles Boulevard. <u>Roads and driveways on Eglinton Avenue</u> <u>between Oriole Parkway and Lascelles Boulevard will have restricted access for approximately four</u> (4) hours for the duration of the work in the immediate area. One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times on Eglinton Avenue. This work is expected to take approximately one (1) week to complete. Upon completion of this work, short term lane reductions may be required to facilitate special activities.

What to Expect

Noise from construction activities including asphalt removals (milling) and asphalt paving can be expected. <u>Roads and driveways on Eglinton Avenue between Oriole Parkway and Lascelles</u> <u>Boulevard will have restricted access for approximately four (4) hours for the duration of the work in the immediate area.</u> Concrete barriers, fencing, and signage will be in place to delineate the work zones. Traffic control personnel and/or a Paid Duty Officer will be present while this work takes place. One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times on Eglinton Avenue East. Expect delays while traveling through the area.

HOURS OF WORK

- As early as Wednesday, July 12, 2023, for approximately one (1) week.
- Milling works will take place daily between 7:30 a.m. 5:00 p.m.
- Paving and line painting works will take place overnight between 8:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.
- Construction activities are expected to take place daily and nightly on Monday Friday.
- Work may be rescheduled due to inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances
- Work may be longer or shorter than expected.

TRAFFIC DETAILS

- Periodic lane reductions will be in place on Eglinton Avenue between Oriole Parkway and Lascelles Boulevard.
- Roads and driveways on Eglinton Avenue between Oriole Parkway and Lascelles Boulevard will have access restricted for approximately four (4) hours for the duration of the work in the immediate area.
- One lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times on Eglinton Avenue.

PEDESTRIAN DETAILS

• A traffic control personnel and/or a Paid Duty Officer will be present to help direct pedestrians across the work zone.
