
Lake Shore East Rail Corridor: Weekend and Overnight Construction

July 21st from 8:00 p.m. to July 23rd at 5:00 a.m.



Construction Update

Construction work is progressing on the Lakeshore East Corridor. Construction crews will be excavating and grading the surface of the expanded rail corridor area between Wolcott Avenue and Birchmount Road. This project will enable the future track construction for improved service along the Lakeshore Corridor.

What work is taking place?



- On Friday, in the section of the corridor west of the Birchmount Road bridge, crews will begin removing the fences that separate workers from the existing tracks. Material along the north side of the corridor under the fence will be excavated at this time.
- On Saturday, crews will place new stone and sub-ballast and on Sunday, crews will conduct fine grading to ensure surface is level and smooth for future work.
- Crews will potentially conduct work on the retaining walls by preparing pile foundations and pre-cast panels. This work would happen east of the Birchmount Road bridge.

What to Expect?

Excavation will require material to be dug up and removed. Due to the nature of this work, residents should expect noise, dust, and vibration. The work area will also be lit to ensure the safety of the workers. Residents will see construction equipment within the rail corridor, including an excavator, dozer, roller, dump/rock truck, drill rigs and concrete trucks.

We understand that this work impacts residents in the surrounding area and Metrolinx is taking all reasonable precautions to minimize disturbances. The following mitigation measures will be implemented:

- · No idling of non-essential equipment
- Keeping reverse operations to a minimum
- Using vehicles and equipment with efficient muffling devices
- Pointing lights away from residential windows
- Routing trucks on main roads where possible

Hours of Work

- Crews will begin working Friday night at 8pm and overnight until Saturday afternoon.
- Work will resume during the day on Sunday.
- No work is expected Saturday and Sunday night.
- Please note that work may be rescheduled due to unforeseen circumstances.

Traffic & pedestrian details

- Traffic and pedestrian impacts are not anticipated with this work.
- Increased construction vehicles and trucks can be expected in the work area.
