Detailed Description

TIMING

- July 24, 2023, to August 14, 2023, approximately.
- Work hours: 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- There may be overnight and weekend work.

IMPACT

- Rolling temporary lane closures.
- Periodic sidewalk and crosswalk closures.
- Temporary relocation of TTC bus stops, if needed.
- Minor field modifications may occur when needed to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public.

LOCATION

• Humber College Boulevard and Hwy 27.

WORK DESCRIPTION

• Road works.

As part of the Finch West Light Rail Transit (LRT) Project, crews will be doing road works at Humber College Boulevard and Hwy 27.

The work is scheduled to start on July 24, 2023, and will last three (3) weeks, approximately. To safely perform the work, the temporary traffic staging as shown above will remain in place.

Work may be rescheduled due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

Please take extra care when navigating near work sites, and always make eye contact with the driver before crossing in front of any equipment or vehicle.

Minor field modifications may occur when needed to complete work safely and minimize impact on the public.

We will continue monitoring noise and vibration levels through spot checks as required during these activities to identify the need for mitigative actions.

WORK HOURS:

- Work will primarily occur Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. There may be overnight and/or weekend work, if needed.
- Signs are installed to keep residents informed about the closure.
- Dates are tentative and may change. Please visit us at www.metrolinx.com/finchwestlrt for up-to-date information.
- Inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances may delay work activities.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- Heavy trucks and equipment in the area.
- Due to the nature of the work, at times there will be dust, noise and vibration associated with this work.
- Nearby businesses and residents can expect noise from excavators, bobcats, vacuum trucks, and other construction equipment caused by road work activities.
- Expect delays near work zones.
- A minimum of one lane of traffic in each direction along Finch Avenue West will be always maintained.
- There will be a Paid Duty Officer, flaggers, and detour signs to direct traffic, as needed.

PEDESTRIAN, TRAFFIC AND TRANSIT DETAILS:

- Road and sidewalk restrictions are in place within the construction area to protect workers and the public.
- Please take extra care when walking near work sites, and always make eye contact with the driver before crossing in front of any equipment or vehicle.
- Pedestrians will be re-routed around the construction area when possible. For safety reasons, pedestrians may be diverted to the sidewalk on the opposite side.
- TTC bus stops will be closed or relocated away from work zones, as needed.
- Relocation of bus stops is done in consultation with TTC.
